FACE COVERING POLICY FOR COURT EMPLOYEES

Pursuant to Administrative Order No. 2020-14 and the Return to Full Capacity COVID-19 Guidelines for Michigan's Judiciary, updated May 2021, this policy governs the use of face coverings for court employees at the 16th Judicial Circuit, Macomb Probate, and 42nd Judicial District Courts. This policy has been developed consistent with the updated MIOSHA Emergency Rules and after assessing the relevant risks in consultation with the Macomb County Health Department.

- 1. All employées are required to wear face coverings while in public spaces, and in courtrooms or hearing rooms during formal or informal proceedings.
- 2. Fully vaccinated employees will not be required to wear face coverings or social distance in other spaces in the Court Buildings.
- 3. "Fully vaccinated" employees means employees that have received their final does of an FDA-approved or authorized COVID-19 vaccine and at least two weeks have passed.
- 4. Signs will be posted in work areas reminding employees that are not fully vaccinated to wear face coverings and maintain appropriate distancing in compliance with the MIOSHA Emergency Rules.
- 5. The Court will provide non-medical grate face coverings to their employees at no cost to the employee if face coverings are required by this policy.
