## MOTION TO SET ASIDE DEFAULTS

Clerks will be allowed to set aside defaults and give defendants a new court date up to the 14-day notice. After the 14-day notice has been sent a motion will be required to set aside the default.

If the motion is filed by an attorney within 6 months of default Judge LeDuc will sign automatically and a formal hearing will be set, anything filed after 6 months even with an attorney will be reviewed on a case by case basis.

If the defendant is pro per and filing his own motion, the Magistrate will hear the motion. This motion date will be set on the Magistrate's traffic docket.

If the defendant's license has been suspended with a FCJ, a bond is required in the amount of the total amount due including late fees and the clearance fee. The clearance fee will not be returned.

All abstracts will be corrected after the court dates.
