

How to Apply for Health Care Coverage
Medicaid, MOMS, Healthy Michigan Plan, MICHild
For Adults, Pregnant Women, Children, Families

The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) offers several ways to apply for health care coverage. Online applications are encouraged and will be processed faster than paper. After completing the application, you will be notified of the programs you and your family members are eligible for. See below for ways to apply and receive help.

4. **Apply with the paper application** which you can download at www.michigan.gov/mdhhs
 - Click on *Assistance Programs*, click *Health Care Coverage*, click *Go to Health Care Coverage*, click *Application for Health Coverage and Help Paying costs*. Complete the fillable form DCH-1426 or download the printable version.
