

The problem with prosecuting violators is that some of the illicit connections were done years ago and not with malicious intent. The phosphorus levels in the lake are high. A company has offered to perform a pilot program where material is put in the drain to help filter out the phosphorus.

The Chair presented the invoice totaling \$247,740.56 to the board for review and approval.


