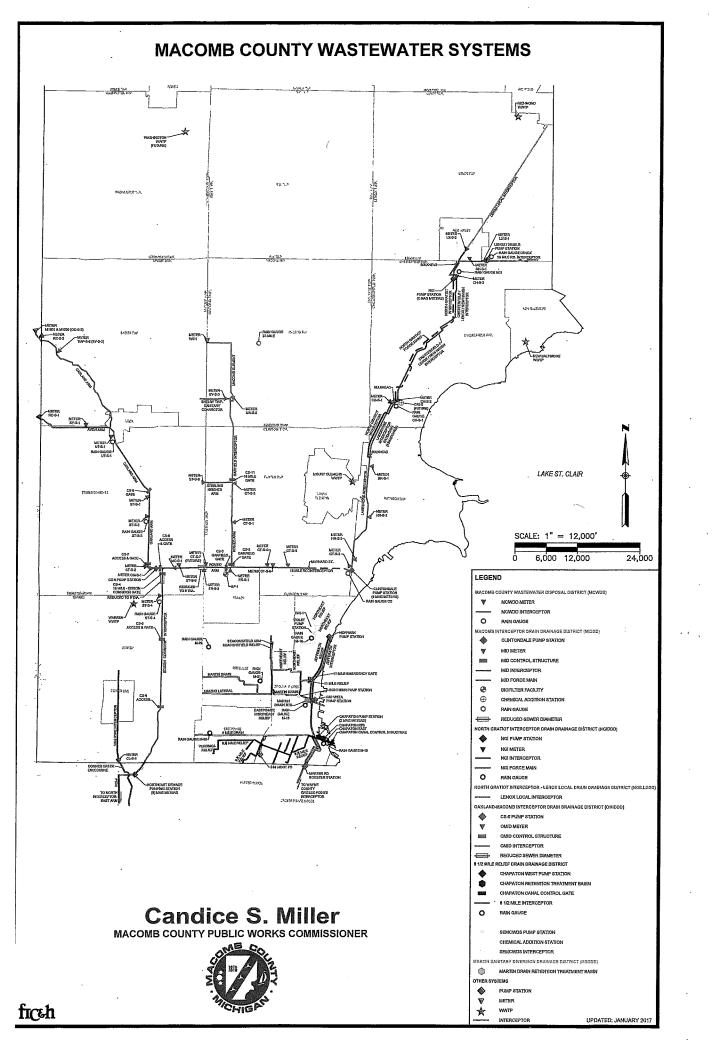

Following is a summary of services completed during the past two weeks and the anticipated tasks for the next two weeks:

Items accomplished during the reporting period:

1. Green Infrastructure Study

a. Finalized draft report and submitted to OMCPWC as well as the Cities of Eastpointe and St. Clair Shores for review.

2. 3D Diagram and Reference Drawings

- a. Finished review and consolidation of reference drawings.
- b. Held meeting with OMCPWC staff to review draft reference drawings.

3. Discharge Protocol

- b. Continued work to confirm pump equation and compare it to meter data.

1. Asset Management Database

a. Work with METCO to place record drawings on OMCPWC server and hyperlink to NEXGEN.

2. Green Infrastructure

a. Finalize report based on comments.
