

The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Candice Miller.

The meeting was opened to public participation, then closed, there being no comments from the public.

Mr. Bednar updated the board on the SAW Grant awarded project. In 2013, SAW Grant applications for all qualifying drains were submitted. The State had approximately \$550 million that they were awarding in up to \$2 million increments. Any public entity could apply for asset management for their various jurisdictions. We applied in 2013 for the Schoenherr Relief and as of this December 2017 it was awarded. When applying for the grant, you had to have your contractors under contract and in this case, it was with Tetra Tech. The kickoff meeting has just been held with Tetra Tech, but assets are unclear. When applied in 2013, it was only applied for the main branch that travels down Schoenherr Road which is the Schoenherr Relief. However we want to review using the funds for the Schoenherr Relief and Branches as well. It has been decided that we gather and identify all our assets of this drain so we can report back to the drainage district. We are prioritizing what assets should be looked at. The main branch along Schoenherr Road has been walked in 2010 which we have records of which will be looked at to see if it is something worth using our grant on the branches that have never been inspected.

Ms. Miller added that this is the drain where E.coli was discovered from a company that had tapped into the drain. This issued has been fixed, the company was very easy to work with. They bought the building approximately 10 years ago and this has been going on way before they moved in. There is another incident on the northern end which is still under investigation and has yet to be found. Jim VanHavermaat and his team have been wonderful to work with.

A motion was made by Mr. Sauger, supported by Ms. Miller to receive and file the project update as presented.
