

The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Candice Miller. The agenda was approved as presented.

Minutes of the meeting of May 8, 2017 were presented and approved on a motion by Mr. Romano, supported by Mr. Santo and unanimously carried.

The meeting was opened to public participation. Mr. Parker, Sterling Heights resident presented his concerns over the mowing of the Sterling Relief Drain. He commended the County on the past practice of keeping the top side, slope and bottom of the drain mowed. The slopes and bottom of the drain are no longer being mowed. Mr. Parker is concerned about ticks and mosquitos and the water flow rate being decreased because of the tall grass. He asked that the City of Sterling Heights and Macomb County work together to keep the grass mowed for easier water flow as the drain was designed. Mr. Parker voiced concern about the smaller animals that live in and around the drain.

Ms. Miller stated that only the top of the bank will be cut. She explained that at each end of the drain there are parcels of land that could be utilized as recreational areas. Green infrastructure and continuation of the bike path are ideas being considered for uses of the land. Letters were sent to residents in the spring about encroachment into the drain easement. Any improvements to the drain will require an assessment to the drainage district.

The public participation portion of the meeting was closed.

Ms. Seymour gave an update on the SAW Grant. The drain is being inspected for the integrity of the pipes, manhole access points and the ditch. A drone will be used to do the initial inspection of the open portions of the drain. Areas noted in the initial inspection to be impaired or needing additional inspection will be physically inspected.

A motion to receive and file the progress report update given by Ms. Seymour was made by Mr. Romano, supported by Mr. Santo and unanimously approved.

The Chair presented the invoices totaling \$10,277.50 to the board for review and approval.

Motion was made by Mr. Santo, supported by Mr. Romano to approve the invoices as presented.

A motion to receive and file the financial report given by Mr. Manning was made by Mr. Romano, supported by Mr. Santo and unanimously carried.
