

## Sterling Relief/Red Run Drain Confluence Habitat Restoration & Regional Trail Connector Project Description

The project will restore over 1.35 miles of riparian areas along the Sterling Relief and Red Run drains in Macomb County as a natural habitat corridor link in order to increase habitat complexity and biodiversity, connect new and existing habitat corridors (Sterling Relief, Red Run, Bousson Drain and Clinton River), benefit native pollinators, control invasive species, plant 475 trees, 2,500 shrubs and 4,000 native pollinator plugs, develop a mile long waterfront trail, and capture and infiltrate an estimated 200,000 gallons of urban stormwater runoff per year from riparian tree plantings. This is continuation of the first two phases of the Sterling Relief Habitat Restoration project. The previous grants did not provide enough funding to continue the native pollinator plantings past Schoenherr road to the confluence with the Red Run Drain, this funding will allow us to continue to those plants all the way to the Red Run and along the Red Run to 16 Mile behind Freedom Hill Park.
