

The meeting was opened to public participation, then closed, there being no comments from the public.

Aloia & Associates, P.C. reviewed the property sale process. An offer system will be posted for a thirty day period. A minimum price is set, offers will be accepted and it is an as-is sale. At the end of the offer period, the highest offer will be used in a live auction of the property. There are 4.8 acres being offered for sale. Once the property is sold, the money will be deposited into the Hawken Drain Drainage District and can be used for maintenance and improvements to the drain.

The Chair presented the invoice totaling \$1,353.75 to the board for review and approval.

A motion was made by Mr. Mijac, supported by Mr. Baker to approve the invoice as presented.
