

Mr. Astorino updated the board that as part of the Southeast Macomb Master Plan, we identified an area within the Martin district to install an in-system storage device. In looking into that project, the Army Corp of Engineers reached out to us to do a project together to reduce CSO's as part of Section 219 funding. The opportunity would be a 75% grant with the district covering the other 25% of the project.
