

Tasks accomplished during the reporting period:

- CTV Contractor has monitored the site for improved ground conditions to access the remaining
 areas to be inspected. Weather has delayed the completion of the CCTV and MH inspections.
 Contractor expects colder weather to firm up the ground by November. An interim deliverable is
 being sent from the CCTV contractor to allow Tetra Tech to begin the condition assessment of what
 has been inspected to date.
- 2. Open Channel Inspection has been completed. A preliminary map indicating the findings has been prepared. Tetra Tech is beginning to analyze the open channel condition data.

If any, as to whether the County would be cleaning or providing a contractor to clean any sewers found with blockages and preventing CCTV cameras from running the line. This question was brought up by the contractor after finding several conditions preventing them from televising. After meeting with the County, it was decided that the County would NOT be cleaning any sewers at this time.
