

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 10:28 a.m.

A motion was made by Mr. Wiley, supported by Mr. Korth to approve the agenda as presented.

The meeting was open to the public participation, then closed, there being no comments from the public.

The minutes of the meeting of January 22, 2019 were presented. A motion was made by Mr. Korth, supported by Mr. Wiley to approve the minutes as presented.

Mr. Stockel updated the board on the Jefferson end of spillway project. Everything has been graded, the driveway and parking area has been installed. There are 12 parking spots. The temporary fence on the west side of Jefferson has been replaced with black vinyl and the gate front has been installed. There was also a cedar split rail fence that was installed on the north side to protect the ditch. In the spring the contractor will go out seed, fertilize and mulch that area and plant more trees to better define the parking area. The parking area is currently open.

Mr. Bednar added that we have not had a crew out to remove the debris from the spillway yet. We have been in contact with the USACE regarding issues related to the spillway and we will continue to talk with them about possibly getting a grant. Also talking with EPA and office of the

Great Lakes to see if we can get some direct funding to better regulate flow to the lower Clinton River. We submitted for a grant opportunity for continued invasive management on all our habitat projects that will help with our maintenance costs for the next 3 years.

Clinton Township has no received new information from the DNR Trust Fund Grant for the excess property so there is no action from us needed at this point regarding the property sale.

Clinton Township is going to be reconstructing their Harper road sanitary lift station and Mr. Bednar reminded them that this is adjacent to staging area fishing pier, and it makes sense for them to come to us with plans to tie the two facilities together.

We won't hear about the Costal Zone Management for the Master Plan until summer, and if successful we could possibly start to move forward this fall.

A motion was made by Mr. Korth, supported by Mr. Wiley to receive and file the project update by Mr. Bednar and Mr. Stockel.

Mr. Stockel informed the board that we received bids for a 2 year contract lawn maintenance. Marino's Landscape came in at the lowest bid.

A motion was made by Mr. Korth, supported by Mr. Wiley to approve the quote form Marino's Landscape for mowing services for the Clinton River Spillway based on the unit prices totaling \$10,660 for the 2019 and 2020 mowing seasons.

Those dates are currently in motion and they are planning for the end of April.

There being no further business, it was moved by Mr. Korth, supported by Mr. Wiley that the meeting of the Clinton River Spillway Inter-County Drainage Board be adjourned.
