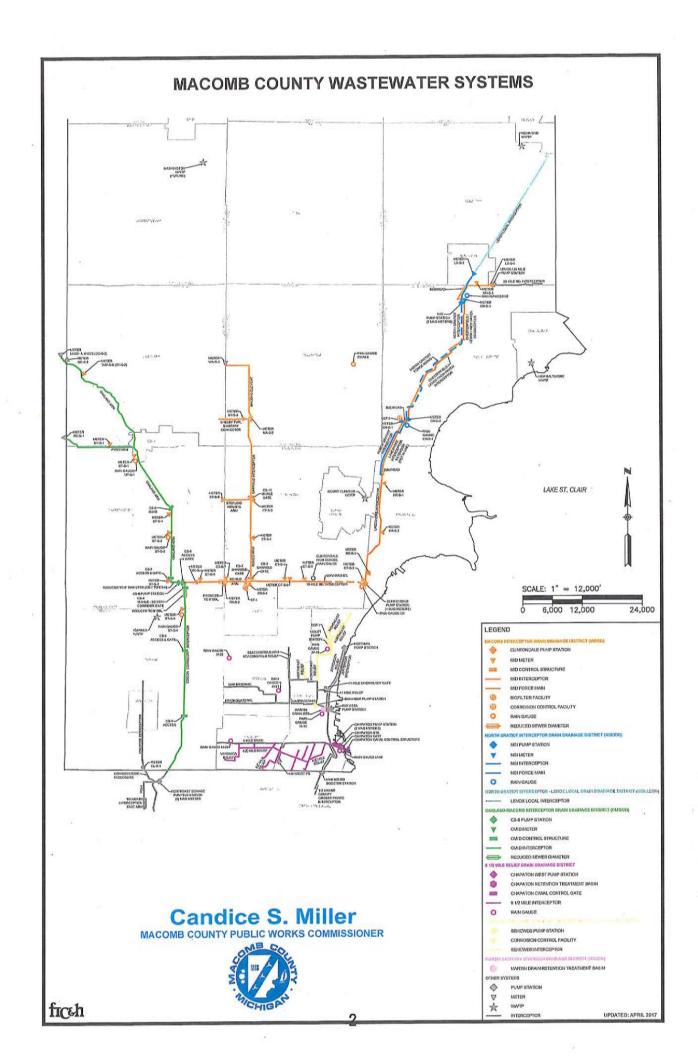

An adjourned meeting of the Intra-County Drainage Board for the **EIGHT AND ONE-HALF MILE RELIEF DRAIN** was held via telephone conference per the State Public Act 254 of 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, on April 12, 2021, at 10:01 A.M.

The meeting was called to order by the Acting Chair, Brian Baker. A motion was made by Ms. Klinefelt, supported by Mr. Santo to approve the agenda as presented.

The meeting was opened to public participation, then closed, there being no comments from the public.

Mr. Astorino updated the board that the Chapaton Pump and Screen project is in the final stages. Testing the new manhole covers went well with no leaks, and the project will be complete shortly.

The Chapaton and Martin disinfection project is still moving along well. The piping within the basin at Chapaton is complete, electrical is near completion, and will begin switching over all the new pumps to the new piping and the project will then be complete at Chapaton. One potential change to the project is our staff will remove the old underground conduit.

The Chapaton Lab and Mezzanine project is nearing completion and the new lab is close to being operational.

A motion was made by Ms. Klinefelt, supported by Mr. Santo to receive and file the project updates by Mr. Astorino.

Mr. Baker updated the board that we received the first petition for the In-System Storage Project. The drain code requires two petitions from the communities. St. Clair Shores had a public hearing and approved the petition and we will be going to the Board of Commissioners on April 21, 2021 to request the second petition from the County.

A motion was made by Mr. Klinefelt, supported by Mr. Santo to receive and file the In System Storage Project petition.

Mr. Bednar presented the board with an opportunity for a \$1.2 million Green Infrastructure project from the Army Corp at Chapaton. When Chapaton was built back in the 1960's it was one of the largest storm water facilities in the world. We continue with innovation at Chapaton to reduce the amount of CSO's to the lake. This project will reduce storm water runoff from the basin decking so that less water flows into the basin. The cost/benefit of the project is very reasonable with the \$900,000 of grant money and this will help reduce overflows and how often we will need to send the overflows for treatment. The Army Corp will manage the project, and work closely with our team regarding changes to be made at the pump station.

A motion was made by Mr. Klinefelt, supported by Mr. Santo to approve the Army Corp Green Infrastructure Project Agreement and \$900,000 grant with a required \$300,000 grant match and authorize the Board Chair to sign the agreement.

Mr. Saph updated the board regarding the renewal for the general liability insurance. This will be the fourth year of securing insurance within the districts and we have established a 3 year prior claims history that needed to be established to consider more insurance companies for coverage. We did end up with the same insurer (Argonaut) as before after taking that information to market as they were still the most competitive. The retention for out of pocket expense for claims dropped from \$250,000 to \$100,000 and this is a more traditional insurance liability program with an underlying policy and an excess policy. There is a change from an occurance form to a claims form which we are more comfortable with. In 2020 we had a \$12 million dollar aggregate and for 2021 we will have a \$11 million dollar aggregate.

A motion was made by Ms. Klinefelt, supported by Mr. Santo to approve the Chapter 20 General Liability Insurance coverage renewal with Argonaut Insurance Company in the amount of \$197,864 (8 ½ Mile share \$10,756.03).

Subject: Construction Projects Status Updates for April 2021 Board Meeting

The following provides a status update for construction work completed within the 8 ½ Mile Relief Drain Drainage District (8MRDDD) for the previous month.

Chapaton Pump & Screen Project

Contractor: J.F. Cavanaugh

Engineering Consultant: HRC

Project Description:

This project consists of the replacement of the influent bar screens, addition of a third intermediate pump, and replacement of the manhole covers located at level B3 within the Chapaton Pump Station. The bar screens have reached the end of their useful life and are critical to protecting the pumps to not allow large objects to enter the wet well. The third intermediate pump is being installed as a redundant measure for dewatering of the in-system storage increased stored flows. The manhole covers are being replaced with pressure rated sealed covers to allow staff to raise the operating level of the wet well by 6 feet. This will provide approximately 3 million gallons of additional storage and will provide additional pumping capacity for the stormwater pumps.

Significant project tasks that have occurred over the past month:

- 1. Majority of punch-list items have been resolved.
- 2. Working on final change order and project close-out.

Chapaton & Martin Disinfection Replacement Project

Contractor: Weiss Construction

Engineering Consultant: Wade Trim

Project Description:

This project consists of the complete replacement of the disinfection systems at Chapaton and Martin. Macomb County Public Works Office (MCPWO) staff identified that a critical capital improvement need for the Chapaton and Martin RTB's was the replacement of the disinfection systems. These are systems that were installed in approximately 1978 and have exceeded the end of their useful life. MCPWO staff has worked diligently to keep the existing disinfection pumps in service as they are prone to failure and require expensive, difficult to obtain parts. The project involves all disinfection chemical feed pumps, new electrical controls and VFDs, and new disinfection and sample piping within the Chapaton RTB.

Significant project tasks that have occurred over the past month:

- 1. Completed all plumbing in Chapaton Basin, tested diffusers, and made piping switchover
- 2. Pulled all wire and performed system startup on new hose pumps.
- 3. Completed all piping demolition and switchover in the Chapaton East Building Pump Room.
- 4. Built electrical equipment racks, mounted VFD cabinets & flowmeter boxes, and ran conduits

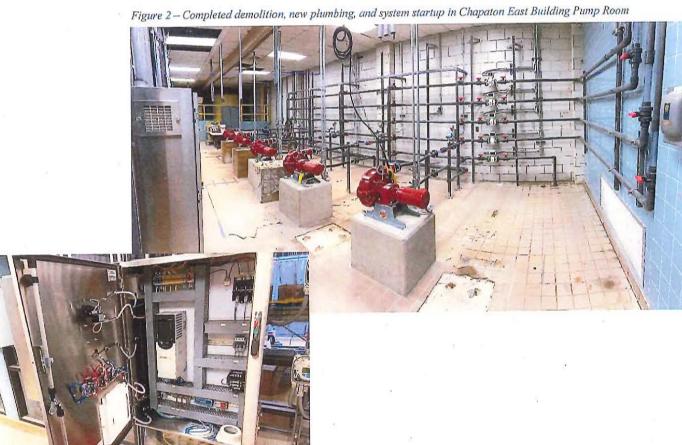


Figure 3 - New wiring and controls for hose pumps

Project Description:

This project consists of relocating the Lab to the Chapaton East Building to allow for the complete overhaul of the Mezzanine level within the Chapaton Pump Station which includes new crew quarters, conference room, kitchen area, and SCADA control room. All areas were original to the facility dating back to 1968 and in need of improvements.

Significant project tasks that have occurred over the past month:

- 1. Completed demolition of Mezzanine level and installed all new interior studs, insulation, drywall, and paint
- 2. Hung ceilings, laid floors, and painted
- 3. Installed new wooden cabinetry in Kitchen and in the SCADA Control Room

1. That the Drainage Board has considered the petition by the City of St. Clair Shores and the Macomb County Board of Commissioners, and hereby tentatively determines the petition is sufficient, and that the drainage project proposed in said petition is practicable.

- 2. That the drainage project petitioned for in said petition may, for brevity, be referred to in the proceedings taken from time to time relative thereto as "Construction of Improvements to the 8 ½ Mile Drain."
- 3. That the name "8 ½ Mile Drain" is continued as the name of the drain to be improved pursuant to the petition and these proceedings.
- 4. That it is tentatively determined the following public corporations be assessed to pay the cost of said project, to wit:

City of St. Clair Shores, Macomb County, Michigan for benefits to the public health;
City of Eastpointe, Macomb County, Michigan for benefits to the public health;
County of Macomb, Michigan for benefits to County roads; and
Michigan Department of Transportation, for benefits to State highways.

- 5. That the Drainage Board will meet on July 12, 2021, at 10 a.m. held virtually via Google Meet, for the purposes of hearing any objections to the proposed drain and the petition for the drain, and to the matter of assessing the costs of the drain to the designated public corporations named above.
- 6. That the notice of said meeting shall be in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit B.
- 7. That said notice shall be published twice in the Macomb Daily, a newspaper published in the County of Macomb, with the first publication to be not less than twenty (20) days prior to the time of said hearing.
- 8. That said notice shall also be sent by the Chairperson of this Drainage Board by certified mail to the Macomb County Clerk, Macomb County Road Department, City Clerk for the City of St. Clair Shores, City Clerk for the City of Eastpointe, and the Director of the Michigan

Department of Transportation, which mailings shall not be less than twenty (20) days prior to the time of said hearing.

The Board of Commissioners offers the following Resolution:

A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR:

Petition requesting maintenance and improvement to the 8 ½ Mile Drain Drainage District.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners ("Board of Commissioners") of the County of Macomb, State of Michigan (the "County"), has determined that the requesting of maintenance and improvement, including without limitation, construction of in-system storage control structures (the "Project"), to the 8 ½ Mile Drain Drainage District (the "Drain") are necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to file a petition with the Macomb County Public Works Commissioner, the form of which is attached as Exhibit A (the "Petition"), pursuant to Chapter 20 of the Drain Code, Act 40, Public Acts of Michigan, 1956, as amended (the "Act 40"), to facilitate implementation of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Clair Shores (the "City") has declared all the lots and parcels of the City as the area to be serviced by the Project, and these parcels will be especially benefited by the Project and that the City may levy a special assessment, charge or fee for all or a portion of the cost of the Project against benefitting properties under section 490 of Act 40 or levy a tax for all or a portion of the cost of the Project against all taxable property within the City pursuant to Chapter 20 of Act 40 including, but not limited to, Section 475; and

WHEREAS, the City, after due and legal notice, held a public hearing to hear objections to the proposed Project and special assessments, fees, or charges to be levied, as required by Section 489a of Act 40 and filed a petition for the Project with the Macomb County Public Works Commissioner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Chair of the Board of Commissioners is hereby authorized and directed to execute and send the Petition to the Macomb County Public Works Commissioner by registered mail.

PETITION FOR MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 20 OF ACT 40 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1956, AS AMENDED

8 1/2 MILE DRAIN DRAINAGE DISTRICT

Pursuant to Chapter 20 of the Michigan Drain Code, Act 40, Public Acts of Michigan 1956, as amended ("Act 40"), the Board of Commissioners of the County of Macomb, State of Michigan (the "County") hereby petitions for an intracounty drain project consisting of maintenance and improvement, including without limitation, construction of in-system storage control structures (the "Project"), to the 8 ½ Mile Drain Drainage District (the "Drain"), which is wholly located and established in the City of St. Clair Shores (the "City"), wholly located within the County.

In a Resolution of the Board of Commissioners duly adopted at its meeting on April 29, 2021, the Board of Commissioners determined that the Project is necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County.

The Project will serve property located within the limits of the County. The Board of Commissioners hereby consents to the Project and it is understood and agreed that the cost of the Project is to be assessed against the City. The City may levy a special assessment, charge or fee for all or a portion of the cost of the Project against benefitting properties under section 490 of Act 40 or levy a tax for all or a portion of the cost of the Project against all taxable property within the City pursuant to Chapter 20 of Act 40 including, but not limited to, Section 475.

All of the lots and parcels of land in the City make up the area to be serviced by the Project. This petition is authorized and sent pursuant to a Resolution of the Board of Commissioners adopted at its meeting of April 29, 2021, a certified copy of which is attached hereto.

The Macomb County Public Works Office (MCPWO) has been diligently working to identify all funding opportunities possible for the two upcoming Chapaton projects. These projects consist of Project 1-9Mile Pump Station and Project 2 – In-System Control Devices. Outside of the potential grant opportunities we are looking to submit for a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan which this year is a 1.875% and 20-year loan in the amount of \$41,027,000. Both of these projects have been presented to the board in March of 2021.

By submitting for this loan, the 8 ½ Mile Relief Drain Drainage District is not required to take the loan or even the full amount of that loan. This project plan submission, if accepted, will put the drain district in the queue for funding at what is currently the lowest possible interest rate available on the market for these projects. There is also potential to receive funding through other sources if the State decides that they are going to fund "shovel-ready" SRF projects grant money.

This project plan was put together by Fishbeck through the as-needed contract. The DRAFT project plan was put out for public review starting on March 22, 2021 and was listed in the Macomb Daily. Copies of the plan were listed on the MCPWO website. On April 26, 2021, a public hearing was held which went through a presentation of the project. No members of the public were in attendance and no questions were sent to MCPWO. If approved today, the final project plan will be submitted by June 1, 2021. The results for funding and the SRF priority list should be published by the end of 2021.

The recommendation for the board is that 8 ½ Mile Relief Drain Drainage District formally adopts said Project Plan and agrees to implement the selected alternative (Alternative 1). Be it further resolved, that the Chief Deputy Macomb County Public Works Commissioner, a position held by Brian Baker, is designated as the authorized representative for all activities associated with the project referenced above, including submittal of said Project Plan as the first step in applying to the State of Michigan for a revolving fund loan to assist in the implementation of the selected alternative.

Macomb County Public Works Office (MCPWO), on behalf of the 8MRDDD, has coordinated a competitive request for proposals for the design of the 8MRDDD 9 Mile Pump Station project.

In 2018, MCPWO commissioned a study of the entire MCPWO wastewater system to develop a Master Plan. As part of this overall Master Plan, the SE Macomb wastewater districts were a key focus. The SE Macomb portion of this has now been completed and one of the key recommendations from the Master Plan team was to build the 9 Mile Pump Station. It was found that current Chapaton Pump Station does not meet firm pump capacity. During large rain events, if one of the large storm weather pumps was to fail or the emergency bypass is needed and lake levels are high the current facility will not be able to handle incoming flows. This has the potential to cause significant flooding impacts in the upstream collection system. A detailed presentation of this was provided to the board during the March meeting.

MCPWO put together a request for proposal package that was posted to MITN on February 22, 2021. The proposals were due on April 22, 2021. For this design package, MCPWO received three proposals which were from AECOM, Tetra Tech, and Wade Trim.

Once receiving the proposals, MCPWO went through its standard scoring process for design which includes a pure technical evaluation before cost is evaluated. From this evaluation, the technical scoring was as follows which is out of 100 total possible points:

- AECOM = 84.83
- Tetra Tech = 96.17
- Wade Trim = 97.83

Once the technical packages were reviewed the cost proposals were then opened and below is a summary of those costs along with what has been budgeted for this project.

Since the scores were so close, MCPWO conducted interviews with all three consultants and their teams. These interviews took place on April 29, 2021. After the interviews scores were provided by the review team and the new total scores are listed below. All scores and costs are summarized in the attached scoring summary sheet as well.

- AECOM = 82.52
- Tetra Tech = 97.13
- Wade Trim = 96.57

The highest scoring team after the interviews was Tetra Tech. Ultimately their vision for this new pump station aligned the best with MCPWO. They also brought forward some potential valuable additions to the project such as integrating power redundancy to the existing Chapaton Pump Station and constructing the new pump station further to the East along with abandoning the existing 9 Mile Road in that area. Tetra Tech has an excellent understanding of the project and a successful history when it comes to design projects at Chapaton. Tetra Tech's predecessor McNamee, Porter and Seeley designed the original Chapaton facility in the early 1960's. They have also worked on numerous other projects within the Chapaton district.

MCPWO has met with Tetra Tech to discuss scope for the project and to finalize costs. Since their original cost proposal of \$1,379,412 there have been a few changes that were made such as adding more time to look at abandoning 9 Mile Road and evaluating the electrical redundancy at Chapaton with the new 9 Mile Pump Station to name a couple. A separate memo has been attached along with the final cost proposal to discuss their cost revisions. This was a negotiated effort and MCPWO is satisfied with where the final changes have come in at \$1,476,428 to provide additional value to the project.

For the budget, we are going to use funds that were collected for flushing improvements in the amount of \$1,328,480. We also have another \$2.3 million available in funds within reserves that have already been collected over the years to rehab the pumps at Chapaton. We can use some of these funds and still have plenty of funding left to cover the upcoming Chapaton Storm pump #2 rehabilitation. Therefore there should be no budget impacts for this design.

MCPWO staff is recommending to award the contract to Tetra Tech in the total NTE amount of \$1,476,428 to perform the work associated with the 9 Mile Pump Station project.

8 ½ Mile Relief Drain Drainage District 9 Mile Pump Station Design Project Scope and Fee Revisions to Tetra Tech Proposal May 5, 2021

This memo is prepared to document the changes in scope and fee from that submitted in the proposal. These changes have been made as a result of the discussions at the interview and scope confirmation meeting.

SCOPE CONFIRMATION

Topographic Surveying – Additional surveying and office analysis will be performed to pick-up topographic and boundary information along East Nine Mile and properties to the south to accommodate the potential to vacate the right-of-way.

An allowance of \$38,660 has been included for additional surveying tasks (such as preparation of legal descriptions and preparation for public hearings) required for the right-of-way being vacated.

Design Flow Verification – This will not be performed and the 600 cfs design flow in the RFP will be used.

Screening — During the BOD, screening options will be evaluated that also treat the gravity discharge to the RTB. This may require a separate screening structure near the existing gravity basin gate into the RTB and our fee reflects a separate structure. A small building on top of the RTB (separate from the main pump station) may need to be designed to house the bar screens, automated cleaning mechanisms, and motorized gates.

We have included modest additional time to remove and redesign gravity gates. The scope does not include time for a new building to be designed. If this is selected, an amendment will be required.

The scope assumes the existing bar screen at the canal will be utilized and a new screen will not be needed.

Pumping – Different pumping arrangements (types and capacities) will be explored during the BOD to maximize utility and minimize O&M. As part of the BOD, Tetra Tech will also evaluate including new

basin flushing pumps integral to the Nine Mile Pump Station. However, time is not budgeted to design flushing pumps and an amendment will be required should this be pursued.

Baffle Wall – Time has not been included to design a baffle wall to route flow to the west end of the structure should that be requested by EGLE. An amendment will be required if EGLE requires this component be added.

Disinfection – Time has been budgeted to evaluate in the BOD if the existing chlorine pumps can be used at the design flow rates. Should new chlorine pumps be needed, the design will be added through an amendment.

Chapaton Electrical Improvements – Should it be determined during the BOD that a new Nine Mile generator can also power a portion of Chapaton Pump Station, wiring and controls to allow this to occur will be designed. Similarly, evaluating new Chapaton Pump Station switchgear will be evaluated during the BOD but design costs will be deferred to a future date when a decision on scope and budget is made.

Architectural – Additional time (40 hours) has been included for revisions made by stakeholders (elected officials, neighbors, planning commissions, etc.).

Electric Vehicle Charging – This scope item will not be pursued within this authorization.

Connecting Chapaton Wet Well to the Proposed 9 Mile Wet Well – This scope item will not be pursued within this authorization.

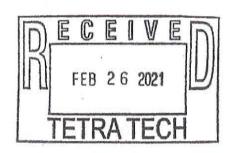
