

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 10:53 a.m.

The meeting was open to the public participation, Dana Duggar, resident of Clinton Township, presented a series of pictures and several environmental concerns related to proper maintenance of the Spillway.

Mr. Bednar updated Mr. Dugger and the Board that they have been looking into who is responsible to mow certain areas along the spillway to make sure we are not missing any areas that should be maintained. He stated that the Grant funded habitat on top of the Spillway banks is to benefit the environment and create a habitat for species that are threatened and endangered. There are only certain times that you would mow those areas.

A motion was made by Ms. Miller, supported by Mr. Nash to receive and file correspondence.

Mr. Bednar updated the Board that as of today, the NOAA Grant has ended. After the meeting they will be touring part of the NOAA funded part of the project. Jamie Burton from HRC will walk the group through. We did see the die off of plantings which are covered by warranty and will be addressed.

The EPA portion of the project will wrap up by the end of the summer. We applied for a Grant through National Fish and Wildlife fund for assistance with invasives treatments along the Spillway and two other AOC Projects. They passed this along to the EPA who picked it up and we may receive funding for invasives management to train our staff and the community staff on what type of maintenance needs to occur and how to do it. Estimated Grant amount is \$200,000. We anticipate an answer on receiving the Grant soon. We also expect to hear back in July or August on the CZM Grant we applied for regarding getting together regionally with communities and see what the demand is for best use.

Mr. Stockel updated the Board that the parking area was completed, and a 600 ft. asphalt cap. We planted some trees and hydro-seeded. Stone was added to the Harper area.

A motion was made by Mr. Suma, supported by Mr. Wiley to receive and file the project update by Mr. Bednar and Mr. Stockel.

Mary Bednar updated the Board that Clinton Township did receive a grant to buy 6.3 acres of property along the Spillway. It went to their Board July 1, 2019 to adopt the resolution to accept the Grant and then the State will have to sign the acceptance of it. They plan to work with the County on what will be done with the land.

A motion was made by Mr. Wiley, supported by Ms. Miller to receive and file the Clinton Township Grant/Spillway Update Property Acquisition update presented by Mary Bednar.

The Chairman presented the invoices totaling \$74,076.00 as provided to the Board for review and approval.
