

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 10:12 a.m.

A motion was made by Mr. Nash, supported by Mr. Baker and unanimously carried to approve the agenda as presented.

The minutes of the meeting of June 28, 2017 were presented. A motion was made by Mr. Baker, supported by Mr. Nash and unanimously carried to approve the minutes as presented.

The Chairman presented the invoice totaling \$520.00 as provided to the board for review and approval.

A map of the area being mowed will be provided at the next meeting.

Motion was made by Mr. Baker, supported by Mr. Nash to approve the invoice as presented.

Ms. Kanan updated the Board on the three proposals approved at the last meeting. The green infrastructure proposal is in the planning stages to determine how to proceed with providing information to the affected communities.

The second proposal concerns infrastructure rehabilitation. Construction plans are being prepared for areas identified in need of repair and should be available at the next meeting. Once completed, specifications and contract documents will be prepared and sent out to bid. The bids will be brought to the Board for approval before work begins.

The third proposal involves drainage district delineation. AEW is working with Stacey Hissong, Fahey, Schultz, Burzych, Rhodes, PLC to map out the Bear Creek Drainage District and its tributaries.

A motion to receive and file the Anderson, Eckstein & Westrick, Inc. progress report was made by Mr. Nash, supported by Mr. Baker.

NAYS: None Motion approved.

There was \$288,000 found in the surplus fund that belongs to the Bear Creek – Warren Branches. The O&M balance for the Bear Creek Drain is \$154,374. The O&M total balance for the Bear Creek Enclosure, Bear Creek GM Enclosure, Bear Creek Warren Branches and Bear Creek Warren Branches #2 is \$1,605,666.

Over the past years, the Bear Creek GM Enclosure has been maintained and repairs paid for by General Motors.

A motion to receive and file the Bear Creek Trial Balance, dated October 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017 as submitted was made by Mr. Nash, supported by Mr. Baker.

There being no further business coming before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 10:27 a.m. by Mr. Gregg on a motion by Mr. Baker, supported by Mr. Nash and unanimously approved.


