

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

A motion was made by Mr. Nash, supported by Mr. Baker and unanimously carried to approve the agenda as presented.

The minutes of the meeting of March 29, 2017 were presented. A motion was made by Mr. Baker, supported by Mr. Nash and unanimously carried to approve the minutes as presented.

The Chairman presented the invoice totaling \$942.50 as provided to the board for review and approval.

Motion was made by Mr. Nash, supported by Mr. Baker to approve the invoice as presented.

AYES: Nash, Baker and Gregg

NAYS: None Motion approved.

Ms. Kanan, AEW updated the Board on the SAW Grant activity. The SAW Grant is in the beginning phases and has 2 ½ years remaining. A bid form was prepared for the CCTV work and given to Doetsch who will provide a cost write-up for the work. Doetsch is a reputable company that has performed work on numerous other SAW grants. A surveyor will locate all the manholes and inspections will be done. A condition assessment and an analysis of what was found will be used to put together an asset management plan.

The engineer's estimate for the work is \$100,000. Ms. Kanan believes that with the previous work done by Doetsch and the fact that there is not an immediate urgency to having the work done, Doetsch will provide a lower price than what was estimated. There are approximately

19,608 linear feet or 3.7 miles of drain that will be inspected. As Doetsch provides their findings, AEW will put together their analysis. Based on the findings, AEW will assign overall ratings to the pipe and determine the criticality of the needed repairs. An assessment will not be done on the recently cleaned syphon, but the sediment will be measured to determine how fast it is collecting in the pipe. AEW will provide written progress reports monthly for the Board's review.

A motion to receive and file the Anderson, Eckstein & Westrick, Inc. report was made by Mr. Nash, supported by Mr. Baker.

A Trial Balance sheet was provided to the Board for review. The O&M balance is approximately \$649,009. Mr. Manning provided a Sharkey Cleanout project cost analysis. Also included was the revenue received from MDOT totaling \$126,669.05 for the syphon cleanout project. An agreement was signed with MDOT in 2016 regarding future cleanouts and responsibility for associated costs.

A motion to receive and file the Sharkey Relief Trial Balance, dated October 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017 as submitted was made by Mr. Baker, supported by Mr. Nash.

There being no further business coming before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 10:10 - a.m. by Mr. Gregg on a motion by Mr. Nash, supported by Mr. Baker and unanimously approved.
