

The meeting was open to public participation, then closed, there being no comments from the public.

Mr. Burton updated the Board on the status of the EPA and NOAA Grants. He stated that the NOAA Grant is officially closed as of June 30, 2019, came in on budget and they were able to deliver more habitat restoration than anticipated. The EPA Grant will be closed on August 31, 2019 and is also on budget. The final reports will be done within 90 days of the Grant close dates.

Mr. Bednar updated the Board that two Grant proposals have been sent out and we should hear back soon if we will receive them. One is a Recreation Master Plan for the corridor, and the other

is a Maintaining Investments grant to provide 2 years additional assistance in invasive species treatment and turning over the AOC projects maintenance responsibility from contracted service to our own staff. We should know by the next Board meeting if we received the grants. There will be in office training and training out in the field for staff in identifying invasive species and in mowing practices.

Mr. Stockel and Mr. Downing updated the Board that all the dogwoods are still alive and there is a 1 year guarantee on them. The fence is cleared to be complete and the materials are ordered. This should be complete in another week. There was also a "no motor vehicles" sign put up.

This Grant Agreement provides assistance to the Macomb County Public Works to implement a project to support the Great Lakes Restoration Initiative (GLRI) to protect and restore the chemical, physical and biological integrity of the Great Lakes Basin ecosystem. The recipient will treat over 100 acres of invasive species in three habitat projects (Clinton River Spillway, McBride Drain, and Partridge Creek) within the Clinton River Watershed Area.
