

A meeting of the Inter-County Drainage Board for the **BEAR CREEK DRAIN** was held in the Office of the Macomb County Public Works Commissioner, 21777 Dunham Road, Clinton Township, Michigan on August 23, 2017.

ALSO PRESENT: Brian Baker, Chief Deputy, Keith Graboske, P.E., Chief Engineer, Tamara Keskeny, Real Property Manager, Bruce Manning, Financial Manager, Tom Stockel, Construction Manager, Madison Tanghe, Senior Secretary, Office of Macomb County Public Works Commissioner; Sydney Kanan, Graduate Engineer, Gordon Wilson, P.E., Anderson, Eckstein and Westrick, Inc. (AEW)

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 10:55 a.m.

A motion was made by Mr. Korth, supported by Ms. Miller and unanimously carried to approve the agenda as presented.

The meeting was open to the public participation, then closed, there being no comments from the public.

The minutes of the meeting of July 26, 2017 were presented. A motion was made by Mr. Korth, supported by Ms. Miller and unanimously carried to approve the minutes as presented.

The Chairman presented the invoices totaling \$8,936.71 as provided to the board for review and approval.

Mr. Graboske indicated that all branches will likely be consolidated into the Bear Creek Drain once the legal review is complete.

A motion was made by Ms. Miller, supported by Mr. Korth to approve the invoices as presented.

AYES: Miller, Korth and Gregg

NAYS: None Motion approved.

Ms. Kanah and Mr. Wilson (AEW) updated the Board on the Bear Creek progress report. Construction plans have been compiled and are in the review process for the Infrastructure Rehabilitation project. Upcoming tasks include compiling the specifications and necessary contract documents. The total cost for the Bear Creek Infrastructure Rehabilitation project estimate is \$500,150.00. AEW will provide estimate for the prioritized portion of all needed repairs at the next meeting.

All pertinent documents have been reviewed and cataloged from Macomb County and Oakland County Offices for the District Delineation project. AEW has started assembling a base map, and calculating the drain right of way. Anticipated tasks include completing the base map and determining what branches of the drain are under the jurisdiction of the Inter-County Drainage Board for Bear Creek.

Upcoming work on the Green Infrastructure project include determining framework for introducing green infrastructure to communities within the Bear Creek Drainage District.

A motion to receive and file the Anderson, Eckstein & Westrick, Inc. progress report was made by Mr. Korth, supported my Mr. Miller.

AYES: Korth, Miller and Gregg

NAYS: None Motion approved.

Ms. Keskeny updated the Board on vacant property. Correction on last meeting, there are five lots in total. Costs \$520.00 to mow the vacant parcels. Two homeowners answered the door out of five and are not interested in taking back the property. If any homeowner out of the remaining three are interested it would be theirs. Ms. Keskeny will also ask the residents on the other side of the parcel. A concept of placing a park on the parcel by Warren Parks and Recreation was proposed along with possibly posting the property for bid.

A motion to further explore options and report back to the Board was made by Ms. Miller, supported by Mr. Korth.

NAYS: None Motion approved.

A summary of all Bear Creek Drain cash balances was provided. The O&M balance is \$244,664.00, Bear Creek Enclosure \$812,054, GM Enclosure \$3,140, Warren Branches \$400,127 and Warren Branches #2 \$134,275 with total available cash balances at \$1.6 million.

A motion to receive and file the Bear Creek Trial Balance, dated October 1, 2016 – July 31, 2017 as submitted was made by Mr. Korth, supported by Ms. Miller.

AYES: Korth, Miller and Gregg

NAYS: None Motion approved.

Mr. Stockel provided an update on the GM Tech. Center sinkhole and concrete wash. Approved plans and permit for the sinkhole have been received. The concrete wash has been sent back out for revisions. Recommend the Board approve both plans and permits as approved by our office and funded by GM; estimated repair cost \$40,000.

Motion to receive and file and approve the permits was made by Mr. Korth, supported by Ms. Miller.

AYES: Korth, Miller and Gregg

NAYS: None

Motion approved.

Mr. Graboske discussed a resolution for each County to approve their own permits instead of taking each permit to the Board. Board suggested this issue to include as part of the ongoing legal review.

The next meeting was scheduled for September 27, 2017.

There being no further business coming before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 11:35 a.m. by Mr. Gregg on a motion by Ms. Miller, supported by Mr. Korth and unanimously approved.

Bear Creek District Delineation Update

We have continued to calculate the various segments of the Bear Creek Drain. This project requires some

additional research due to the complexity or vague nature of the descriptions. For example, a number of

descriptions are portions of a lot in a subdivision. That requires researching and calculation of the sub to

locate the lot, and then located the right of way on the lot. Some descriptions reference lots by the name

of the owner circa 1910. We have access to 1916 atlas, from which we are able to approximate the

locations of those properties. The metes and bounds are fairly straight forward legal descriptions, but we

need to locate the section corners from which they begin.

So far, we have had all of the research information available in our office and we have not had to go into

the field for additional information. I am currently working on a description that only references the end

of the pipe at the Mound Road crossing as a point of beginning. Using Google Earth and some older tax

maps, we believe we have a reasonable location with which to identify the section of the drain

described. It just takes time.

After speaking to Warren Planning it seems that in order to give the property owners a portion of the surplus property, the Bear Creek Drain Board would need to split and possibly combine, depending on how many residents are interested and the details, that would be determined if the Board decides to move forward with the land split.

Ron Wuerth, Planning Director, Warren, stated that a survey would be needed as well to determine property lines.

If the Board agrees, I will send the letter out to the nine residents to find out the interest in relinquishing the surplus property to them.

If the Board agrees, I will get two quotes for a survey.

Dear Resident,

The Bear Creek Drain Drainage District is looking to transfer ownership of the vacant property located in the attached image. We are interested in getting feedback from the property owners regarding their potential interest in obtaining a portion of this Bear Creek property. Our preferred option is to gift a portion of this surplus property to the adjoining property owners. There are a few items that you need to know if you have an interest in any portion of the property:

- There would be no cost to you should a portion get deeded to you.
- The new property owner would be responsible for the mowing, upkeep and taxes on this property.
- This property may be used for recreational use but it will not be acceptable to place a permanent structure (such as a garage on said property).
- Macomb County Public Works would maintain an easement for the Bear Creek Drain, (an easement is a non-possessory right to use and/or enter onto the real property of another without possessing it). This easement allows the Bear Creek Drain District access to the property if at some time there needs to be work or maintenance done on the drain.
- Should you not want a portion of the property that is located directly behind your residence, your neighbors will be given the opportunity to take possession of the land.

LOT SPLIT AND COMBINATION APPLICATION

Procedures

Subdivision Lot Split Procedure (Creating a new split line)

- Petitioners may schedule a meeting with Planning Staff to conduct a preliminary review of the proposed lot split in order to identify issues which may arise during the review process. This preliminary meeting is not a requirement.
- 2. A completed application, including the affidavit of ownership, twenty-four (24) copies of the required plans and applicable fee must be submitted to the Planning Department. Requests in compliance with Zoning Ordinance requirements will be placed on a Planning Commission agenda in accordance with the submittal schedule prepared by the Planning Staff. Please note that all required variances must be obtained before an item will be placed on a Planning Commission agenda for approval.
- 3. The petitioner will receive a notice informing them of the Planning Commission public hearing scheduled for their item. Attendance at the Planning Commission meeting is mandatory.
- 4. The Planning Commission will hold a public hearing and issue their recommendation regarding the request. This recommendation is forwarded to City Council. The petitioner will also receive formal correspondence from the Planning Commission secretary detailing the Planning Commission's recommendation.
- 5. The petitioner will receive a notice informing them of the City Council public hearing scheduled for their item. Attendance at the City Council meeting is mandatory.
- 6. City Council will hold a public hearing and either approve or deny the request.
- 7. Any conditions applied to City Council's approval of the request must be completed before the City Clerk will record a certified copy of the resolution with the Macomb County Register of Deeds. Approval of the request will be revoked if the petitioner does not complete the conditions imposed by the City Council Resolution within one (1) year.

Re-establishing a Platted Lot Line (Subdivision Parcel Split Procedure)

- 1. Petitioners may schedule a meeting with Planning Staff to conduct a preliminary review of the proposal in order to identify issues which may arise during the review process. This preliminary meeting is not a requirement.
- 2. A completed application, including the affidavit of ownership, fourteen (14) copies of the required plans and applicable fee must be submitted to the Planning Department.
- 3. Planning staff will conduct a review of the proposal and forward a copy to the Assessing Department and the Building Division for their review.
- 4. The Planning Department will administratively approve or deny the request and notify the petitioner of the decision no more than forty-five (45) days after the submission of a complete application package. The Planning Department may make the approval conditional upon receiving acceptable revised plans, etc.
- 5. If the proposal is approved and all of the conditions have been met, the proposal will be forwarded to the office of the City Clerk for record at the Macomb County Register of Deeds and to the Office of the City Assessor for assignment of a new parcel identification number.
