

Mr. Bednar updated the Board that we are finishing the operations and maintenance plan funded by the GLRI grants and will present those to the Board once both are complete.

We did receive funding from another EPA grant for approximately \$190,000. The first round of maintenance this fall will be completed under that grant. EPA will work with our staff, Clinton Township, and Harrison Township staffs on how to maintain these investments.

Mr. Gregg addressed a tree cutting complaint from Mr. Duggar. Mr. Duggar states there is a tree that was cut near his house on the Union Lake side of the Spillway. We will have someone investigate it and ensure it is on the drain maintenance list.

Mr. Stockel updated the board that the fencing and gate along the Spillway will be complete in the next week and there will be access if vehicles need to enter the Spillway.

Good Morning Brian,

There are a few issues still needing action on the Spillway property. I would have brought these to the September meeting had it not been canceled.

- 1. When will Illegal dumping and tree cutting on the north side of property near Union Lake Rd. be cleaned up?
- 2. What is status of actions to address preventing future dumping? Letters to adjacent property owners? Extension of fence at south end of Union Lake?
- 3. When will audit of surviving shrub and trees planted mid summer occur, so they can be replaced under warranty?
- 4. What is the status of phragmyte eradication? There are still many thriving areas of the plants.
- 5. The dumping that occurred last fall on the north side near the compressor building still has not been cleaned up. What steps have been taken to prevent a repeat this fall?
- 6. Mowing: At the July meeting, it was stated that mowing would be reviewed. (because it could only be done certain times of the year) Even the areas adjacent to the Harper Ave. parking lot have been allowed to have a look of squalor.

It is time to put the so called "habitat" card on the bottom of the deck and return to maintaining an attractive appearance to the back yard of our neighborhood.

What mowing is going to be done this season?
On a positive note:  The Charter Township of Clinton has done a great job keeping the Sheffield parcel mowed. Likewise the area along Wellington Crescent has returned to having an attractive and cared for appearance. (not sure who is doing this work)
