

They received it very positively and are considering budgeting for this work. They expect a decision in the first quarter of 2020.

Project kickoff for the Mound project happened October 15. They are looking at each crossing structurally and are looking for input on anything flow wise that needs to be changed. Macomb Department of Roads will follow up with our office.

Mr. Stockel and Mr. Bednar stated that the BP gas station has submitted plans for a retaining wall, and will make changes based on our recommendations regarding that plan. They plan to start in November.
