Mr. Bednar updated the Board that we did get the grant from the EPA for continued maintenance support, but could not activate it for the fall. We need to bid for services first and have the bid open for at least 30 days which put us out of the window of doing the frag invasive treatment for this fall. The work will be done in the spring. We sent out staff to collect seed heads and collected 30 plus, 50 gallon bags of seed heads before doing fall work as to not spread the invasive seeds.

We did not get the CZM grant, and we will work on being awarded that grant for next year.

Mr. Bednar had a meeting with the Army Corp of Engineers and their flood plain management services group to talk about the Spillway and what impacts certain hydraulic modifications to the Spillway could have regionally. Army Corp are interested in the impact and doing the analysis next year.

Mr. Downing stated that when out doing Spillway cleanup, Mr. Duggar was out on the Spillway mowing a path. Mr. Duggar and Mr. Baker have talked and have addressed some issues to prevent future dumping. At the Harper Avenue fishing pier, the snow fence was intended to be temporary, and we are assessing when it will be taken down as it is there to protect some of the new trees. We have also reached out to a fencing contractor to further secure the property from trespassing and dumping.

Mr. Duggar was mowing a path from near the fishing pier to the access road where he likes to walk as it is fenced off. Mr. Baker told him he could not mow this area, and that we will put in a pedestrian access point for those who like to walk the Spillway access road. We will also add a fence and sign saying "no dumping" to help detour dumping that has occurred near Union Lake.

A motion was made by Mr. Baker, supported by Mr. Wiley to authorize the purchase of sign, fence and gate for the cost of \$3,500.





Spillway Park is located just north of the mouth of the Clinton River Spillway on the eastside of Jefferson. The site is accessible from a dedicated parking lot as well as the Freedom Trail. This project will add a Universal design Compliant Kayak Launch near the entrance to the park. The launch will give kayakers immediate access to the Lake St. Clair Shoreline. Kayakers will also be within two miles of Lake St. Clair Metro Park.

The launch will be Universal design compliant in order to ensure that it is accessible to residents with disabilities. It will extend into the mouth of the spillway at the end of the Clinton River Trail by a short gangway along the natural shoreline. Engineering of the project will be completed by the Township firm, Wade Trim, once the grant is approved. Construction will start shortly thereafter.

Request for Approval of Grant Application and Matching Funds

Please see the attached resolution approving the submission of a Coastal Zone Management (CZM) grant application and matching funds for master plan development of the Clinton River Spillway and adjacent lands. The total project cost is proposed for not more than \$40,000 with 50% funded by the grant. If approved, in-kind services will comprise at least \$10,000 and no more than \$10,000 cash.

This application is essentially the same as was submitted last year and was denied. After comments from the CZM management group, the narrative will be amended to emphasize that feedback but the budget and proposed schedule remain as originally proposed. The deadline for application submittal is December 20, 2019.

It is hoped that as other funding sources arise, a master plan will guide activities in and access to the Spillway in an effective and coherent fashion for the benefit of the community.





Whereas, The Spillway Inter-County Drainage Board has determined it necessary to develop a master plan for the Clinton River Spillway and adjacent public land, to improve recreational opportunities and lower annual maintenance costs.
Whereas, Funding is available from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) through the Michigan Coastal Zone Management Program for planning studies within shoreline areas.
Whereas, the total project cost is estimated at no more than \$40,000, of which 50% will be funded through CZM and 50% through local match.
Therefore be it resolved that, The Spillway Inter-County Drainage Board does hereby approve the submission of a grant application to the Michigan Coastal Zone Management Program for the total cost of no more than \$40,000 for the Spillway Master Plan and commits to the local match consisting of in-kind services of no less than \$10,000 and cash of no more than \$10,000 if the project is funded by means of the passing of this resolution, hereby adopted on November 20, 2019.
