

The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Candice Miller. The agenda was approved on a motion by Mr. Mijac and supported by Mr. Santo.

Minutes of the meeting of October 16, 2017 were presented and approved on a motion by Mr. Santo, supported by Mr. Mijac and unanimously carried.

The meeting was opened to public participation, then closed, there being no comments from the public.

Mr. Bantios updated the board on the progress of the sinkhole repair project. To date, four lanes of 15 Mile Road have been paved and work will begin on the center lane and curb and gutter. Ninety percent of the sidewalks have been installed. The last of the sanitary and watermain repairs are being finished. Final restoration will take place in the spring of 2018. Once the ground stabilizes, the two vacant lots and the house can be appraised and sold.

Mr. Astorino gave an update on the inspection of the MID Interceptor and local connectors. Data will be compiled into one package and be available by December 12, 2017. The next step will be to analyze the data to put together a project plan to apply for State Revolving Fund (SRF) monies for necessary repairs. Bids will go out today for hiring a tunnel expert to analyze the data and put together a project plan so that the County can apply for State Revolving Fund (SRF) monies to do the necessary repairs. A meeting will be held with the MID communities to discuss the findings and next steps.

A motion to approve Change Order No. 6 from Dan's Excavating, Inc. for rehabilitation of Control Structure 2 and Control Structure 3 steel gates and installation of a 2.5" thick shotcrete spray on liner for the 8' diameter PCI-12A Interceptor for an increase of \$340,868.62 was made by Mr. Mijac and supported by Mr. Santo.

This is an open competitive contract. The Request for Proposals (RFP) was advertised from November 14, 2017 to November 29, 2017 on the Michigan Inter-Governmental Trade Network (MITN) website. A total of 1764 solicitations were sent out via MITN. A total of 82 firms downloaded the RFP.

Two (2) Addendums were issued during the course of the RFP. The Addendums addressed questions received during the open question period.

On November 29, 2017, proposals were received from 15 firms. One firm, NTH, was disqualified due to improper submission of the cost section, which was required to be enclosed in a separate sealed envelope. Each member of the Evaluation Committee reviewed the proposals and shortlisted the top three firms in each sub-discipline. The shortlisted firms were scored on a scale of 0 to 10, with the firm receiving a 10 being recommended for award. The proposers were scored as follows:

#### SETTLEMENT AND RELEASE AGREEMENT

This Settlement and Release Agreement (the "Agreement") is made as of November \_\_, 2017, by and between the Macomb County Public Works Commissioner Candice S. Miller ("Macomb Public Works Commissioner") in her official capacity and on behalf of Macomb County under Act 342; the Macomb Interceptor Drain Drainage District ("MIDDD"); the Oakland Macomb Interceptor Drain Drainage District ("OMIDDD"); Jim Nash in his official capacity, on behalf of Oakland County under Act 342, and as Secretary of the Inter-County Drainage Board for the OMIDDD; the Clinton-Oakland Sewage Disposal District ("COSDS"); and Michael Gregg, as Chairman of the Inter-County Drainage Board for the OMIDDD (OMIDDD, Jim Nash, and Michael Gregg, collectively, "Defendants") (all of the above collectively, "Parties" or individually "Party"), based upon the following facts:

- A. OMIDDD is an inter-county drain established pursuant to Chapter 21 of the Drain Code, PA 40 of 1956 as amended, that delivers wastewater from Oakland and Macomb County communities to the Northeast Sewage Pump Station previously operated by the City of Detroit's Water and Sewage Department ("DWSD") and now operated by the Great Lakes Water Authority ("GLWA").
- B. OMIDDD was formed to take ownership, operation, and control of the Oakland Macomb Interceptor from the DWSD pursuant to a Global Settlement Agreement dated May 12, 2009 between Detroit, the DWSD, Macomb County, Oakland County, and Wayne County. The United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan entered the Global Settlement Agreement on May 18, 2009 in case no. 77-771100.
- C. The Inter-County Drainage Board for the OMIDDD (the "Board"), which held its first meeting on July 14, 2009, consists of the public works commissioners (or water resource commissioners) of Oakland County and Macomb County and the Director of the Michigan Department of Agriculture & Rural Development (or the Director's designee).
- D. OMIDDD is undergoing a multiyear rehabilitation improvement project of approximately \$164 million to assure proper wastewater transportation services from certain Oakland and Macomb communities that make up the OMIDDD. The improvements are required to comply with an Order Establishing a Compliance Schedule for Interceptor dated June 30, 2009.
- E. As a result of disputes arising between the members of the Board at the time involving project management and the "service area" of the OMIDDD, on June 27, 2013, the Macomb Public Works Commissioner's predecessor, Anthony V. Marrocco ("Marrocco"), filed a complaint (the "Complaint") in the Macomb County Circuit Court. The matter was later assigned to the Honorable Michael West of the 31<sup>st</sup> Judicial Circuit Court in St. Clair County pursuant to MCL 280.532.
- F. The Complaint contained two counts. Count I, titled "Breach of Contract for Declaratory Relief, Specific Performance and Damages," alleged that the city of Warren was within the OMIDDD service area (the "Service Area") contemplated in OMIDDD's services agreement with Macomb County dated October 1, 2009 (the "Macomb Agreement"), and

OMIDDD's refusal to include the city of Warren in the OMIDDD Service Area as demanded by Marrocco constituted a breach of contract. Count II of the Complaint was titled "Breach of Fiduciary Duties for Declaratory Relief Specific Performance and Damages" and alleged that OMIDDD's refusal to appoint Marrocco as secretary of the Board and project manager, as well as reimbursement of Oakland County for its "Maximus" costs, constituted a breach of fiduciary duties.

- G. In fall 2014, the parties filed cross-motions for summary disposition. On March 5, 2015, the trial court issued an Opinion and Order. As to Count I, the trial court granted Marrocco declaratory relief and held that the city of Warren was included in the Service Area contemplated in the Macomb Agreement. As to Count II, the trial court granted Defendants' Motion for Summary Disposition and declined Marrocco's requests for writs of mandamus or superintending control, finding that there was no genuine issue of material fact to support the claims of Count II that OMIDDD's refusal to appoint Marrocco as secretary of the Board and project manager, as well as reimbursement of Oakland County for its "Maximus" costs, constituted a breach of fiduciary duties.
- H. On March 24, 2015, Defendants filed a Claim of Appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals, seeking a review of the trial court's order relating to Count I (Docket No. 326575). On May 28, 2015, Marrocco filed a Claim of Appeal seeking a review of the trial court's order relating to Count II (Docket No. 327614).
- I. On June 16, 2016, the Court of Appeals entered an opinion reversing the trial court's grant of summary disposition as to Count I of the Complaint and affirming the trial court's grant of summary disposition as to Count II of the Complaint. The Court of Appeals remanded the case back to the trial court for further proceedings regarding Count I.
- J. On August 9, 2016, the Court of Appeals awarded costs in favor of Defendants in the amount of \$1,060.80.
- K. On July 28, 2016, Marrocco filed an application for leave to appeal the Court of Appeals' June 16, 2016 opinion in the Michigan Supreme Court (Docket No. 154166). On May 2, 2017, the Michigan Supreme Court denied the application for leave to appeal.
- L. The proceedings in the 16<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit Court, 31<sup>st</sup> Judicial Circuit Court, the Michigan Court of Appeals, and the Michigan Supreme Court are collectively referred to as the "Litigation."
- M. In order to avoid the time, effort, and expense of litigating the claims in the Litigation released herein, for and in consideration of the mutual promises, warranties, and covenants herein contained, and without any admissions by any Party concerning the merit or lack of merit of any of their claims or defenses, the Parties have agreed and do agree as follows:

#### 1. The OMIDDD Service Area.

The Parties agree that the Service Area of the OMIDDD is as depicted in **Exhibit 1** of this Agreement, which includes the City of Auburn Hills, Independence Township (including the City of Clarkston), the City of Lake Angelus, the City of Rochester, the City of Rochester Hills,

Oakland Township, Orion Township, Oxford Township, the Village of Lake Orion, the Village of Oxford, Waterford Township, and West Bloomfield Township, each in Oakland County; Chesterfield Township, the City of Fraser, the City of Sterling Heights, the City of Utica, Clinton Township, Harrison Township, Lenox Township, Macomb Township (including Washington Township), Shelby Township, and the Village of New Haven, each in Macomb County; and subareas depicted in Exhibit 1 in Springfield Township, Oakland County for the Softwater Lake Development, and White Lake Township, Oakland County for the White Lake Oaks County Park and Golf Course. The Parties agree that Sections 1, 3, and 4 of this Agreement shall replace and supersede paragraph 6 of the Macomb Agreement, as well as paragraph 6 of the agreement between OMIDDD and Oakland County dated September 1, 2009 (the "Oakland Agreement"), entitled "Service Area," and that Exhibit 1 of this Agreement shall hereinafter serve as the Service Area of the OMIDDD for all purposes. The parties agree that the changes to the Macomb Agreement and the Oakland Agreement described in this Section 1 are subject to the prior written approval of the GLWA. In addition to the provisions of Section 9, each Party warrants and covenants to the other that it, he, or she has the legal right, power, capacity, and authority to enter into and perform the requirements of this provision of the Agreement.

#### 2. Construction of Direct Tie-Ins to the OMIDDD System.

#### (a) Warren Direct Tie-In.

The Parties agree to allow Warren to join the OMIDDD system, through the construction of two new points of discharge, pursuant to the terms and conditions the Board, in its sole discretion, sets forth, including the requirement that Warren pay to the OMIDDD an initial buyin cost at an amount set by the Board. Warren's inclusion into the OMIDDD is subject to the prior written approval of the GLWA.

#### (b) Direct Tie-In of Other Communities.

The Parties agree that no new discharge points into the OMIDDD system will be constructed without an affirmative vote of the Board and subject to the terms and conditions the Board sets forth. The construction of any additional discharge points is subject to prior written approval of the GLWA.

# 3. <u>Communities the Parties May Add to OMIDDD Through Existing</u> Connections.

## (a) Communities Macomb/MIDDD May Add to the OMIDDD System.

The Parties agree that the following Macomb County communities may deliver wastewater to the OMIDDD system through existing discharge points into the OMIDDD system and not through any new discharge points into the OMIDDD system as depicted in Exhibit 1: Bruce, Armada, Richmond, and Ray Townships (or any portion of a city or village located therein). No further OMIDDD buy-in will be required for the communities added to the OMIDDD system pursuant to this paragraph to join the OMIDDD system through existing discharge points. The MIDDD may, in its sole discretion, establish, collect, and retain any connection or buy-in charges for any communities added to the OMIDDD system pursuant to this paragraph. The Parties agree that, although communities added to the OMIDDD system

pursuant to this paragraph may be added through existing discharge points, those communities located in Macomb County discharging into the OMIDDD may not collectively exceed the Maximum Allowable Flow Limit of 283 cfs outlined in paragraph 8 of the Macomb Agreement. Subject to this Maximum Allowable Flow Limit of 283 cfs, the MIDDD and its member communities may alter the allocation of flow among MIDDD member communities in the OMIDDD system. Any alteration in the allocation of flow among MIDDD member communities in the OMIDDD system will not change any obligation to pay under the Final Order of Apportionment adopted by the OMIDDD Board. Moreover, the Parties agree that all communities added to the OMIDDD system pursuant to this paragraph will be subject to the prior written approval of the GLWA and all apportionments for maintenance and capital expenditures arising after their connection, and that the OMIDDD will not bear the cost of any such connection.

### (b) Communities Oakland/COSDS May Add to the OMIDDD System.

The Parties agree that the following Oakland County communities may deliver wastewater to the OMIDDD system through existing discharge points into the OMIDDD system and not through any new discharge points into the OMIDDD system as depicted in Exhibit 1: Addison, Brandon, Groveland, Holly, Rose, Springfield, White Lake, and Highland Townships (or any portion of a city or village located therein). No further OMIDDD buy-in will be required for the communities added to the OMIDDD system pursuant to this paragraph to join the OMIDDD system through existing discharge points. The COSDS may, in its sole discretion, establish, collect, and retain any connection or buy-in charges for any communities added to the OMIDDD system pursuant to this paragraph. The Parties agree that, although the communities added to the OMIDDD system pursuant to this paragraph may be added through existing discharge points, those communities located in Oakland County discharging into the OMIDDD may not collectively exceed the Maximum Allowable Flow Limit of 140 cfs outlined in paragraph 8 of the Oakland Agreement. Subject to this Maximum Allowable Flow Limit of 140 cfs, the COSDS and its member communities may alter the allocation of flow among COSDS member communities in the OMIDDD system. Any alteration in the allocation of flow among COSDS member communities in the OMIDDD system will not change any obligation to pay under the Final Order of Apportionment adopted by the OMIDDD Board. Moreover, the Parties agree that all communities added to the OMIDDD system pursuant to this paragraph will be subject to the prior written approval of the GLWA and all apportionments for maintenance and capital expenditures arising after their connection, and that the OMIDDD will not bear the cost of any such connection.

#### 4. Board Approval Required for Modifications to Service Area.

Except as provided in paragraph 3, the Parties agree that any addition, removal, modification, or amendment to the OMIDDD Service Area shall be in accordance with the Drain Code, PA 40 of 1956 as amended.

#### 5. Order of Dismissal.

The Parties mutually agree that upon execution of this Agreement by all Parties, the Parties shall cause their counsel to deliver to the 31<sup>st</sup> Judicial Court for signing the Order of Dismissal, with prejudice and without costs, attached as **Exhibit 2**.

#### 6. Award of Costs in the Court of Appeals.

Defendants agree not to execute on, and to waive all rights with respect to, the Court of Appeals' August 9, 2016 award of costs in the amount of \$1,060.80.

#### 7. Macomb County/MIDDD Release.

Except for obligations created by or arising out of this Agreement, the Macomb Public Works Commissioner in her official capacity, for Macomb County under Act 342, and on behalf of the MIDDD and their affiliated departments, agencies, public officials, boards, predecessors, successors, heirs and assigns, licensors, licensees, assignors and assignees, absolutely and forever releases and discharges Defendants, and any and all affiliated or related departments, agencies, public officials, board members, parents, subsidiaries, joint ventures, trustees, heirs, attorneys, agents, employees, licensees, sublicensees, assignees, and successors or assigns thereof, of and from any and all claims, demands, liabilities, debts, obligations, accounts, actions and causes of action, known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, at law or in equity, that any of the foregoing may have or have had as of the date hereof that were asserted in the Litigation or which arise out of the same transactions or occurrences as the Counts asserted in the Complaint.

#### 8. Defendants' Release.

Except for obligations created by or arising out of this Agreement, Defendants and COSDS, for themselves, and their affiliated departments, agencies, public officials, boards, predecessors, successors, heirs and assigns, licensors, licensees, assignors and assignees, absolutely and forever release and discharge the Macomb Public Works Commissioner, Macomb County, the MIDDD, and any and all affiliated or related departments, agencies, public officials, board members, parents, subsidiaries, joint ventures, trustees, heirs, attorneys, agents, employees, licensees, sublicensees, assignees, and successors or assigns thereof, of and from any and all claims, demands, liabilities, debts, obligations, accounts, actions and causes of action, known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, at law or in equity, that Defendants or any of the foregoing may have or have had as of the date hereof that were asserted in the Litigation or which arise out of the same transactions or occurrences as the Counts asserted in the Complaint.

- 9. <u>Warranties And Representations</u>. Each Party warrants, represents and covenants to each other that:
  - (a) Each has full legal right, power, capacity and authority to enter into and perform this Agreement.
  - (b) This Agreement constitutes a valid, binding and enforceable agreement of the Parties hereto.

- (c) Each has not assigned any claim being released by it hereunder to any third party.
- (d) Each will not bring any action, claim or file any lawsuit against the other with respect to claims released hereunder.
- 10. <u>No Admissions</u>. The execution of this Agreement effects the settlement of remaining claims of Plaintiff which are contested and denied. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as an admission of any Party hereto of any liability to any other Party.
- 11. <u>Binding Nature</u>. The Parties agree that this Agreement and all of its terms shall be binding upon their respective heirs, legal successors, trustees, assigns, assignors, licensors and licensees.
- 12. <u>Integrated Agreement</u>. The Parties agree and acknowledge that this Agreement constitutes and contains the entire agreement and understanding of the Parties concerning the subject matter hereof, and supersedes and except as specifically set forth herein, replaces all prior negotiations, proposed agreements, or agreements, written, oral, or implied. The Parties further agree that any oral representations or modifications concerning this Agreement shall be of no force or effect, and that this Agreement, including this provision, can be modified only by a writing signed by all of the Parties. The Parties acknowledge, one to the other, that no other Party, nor any agent or attorney of any other Party, has made any promise, representation, or warranty whatsoever (express, implied, or statutory) not contained herein concerning the subject matters hereof, to induce them to execute this Agreement; and that they have not executed this Agreement in reliance upon any such promise, representation, or warranty not contained herein.
- 13. <u>Informed Consent</u>. The Parties acknowledge that they have been represented by independent legal counsel of their own choice throughout all of the negotiations which preceded the execution of this Agreement or that they have had a full and fair opportunity to consult with such counsel and to make whatever investigation or inquiry they may deem necessary or desirable in connection with the subject matter of this Agreement prior to the execution hereof and the delivery and acceptance of the consideration specified herein.
- 14. <u>Construction</u>. No Party, nor any of the Parties' counsel, shall be deemed the drafter of this Agreement for purposes of interpreting any provision hereof in any judicial or other proceeding that may arise between or among them.
- 15. Severability. In the event that any covenant, condition or other provision herein contained is held to be invalid, void or illegal by any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall be deemed severable from the remainder of this agreement and shall in no way affect, impair or invalidate any other covenant, condition or other provision herein contained. If such covenant, condition or other provision shall be deemed invalid due to its scope or breadth, such covenant, condition or other provision shall be deemed valid to the extent of the scope or breadth permitted by law. If, for any reason, any clause or provision of this Agreement is deemed invalid, the Parties desire that such clause or provision shall be amended to achieve as full as possible the intent of the Parties and the remainder of the Agreement shall remain in full force and continue to be binding upon the Parties.

- 16. <u>Headings</u>. Titles and captions in this Agreement are inserted only as a matter of convenience and are for reference purposes only. Such titles and captions are intended in no way to define, limit, expand, or describe the scope of this Agreement or the intent of any other provision.
- 17. Governing Law. This Agreement shall in all respects be interpreted, enforced, and governed by and under the laws of the State of Michigan.
- 18. <u>Execution And Counterparts</u>. This agreement may be executed in counterparts. Such counterparts, when taken together, shall constitute the agreement between the Parties.
- 19. <u>Photographic And Facsimile Copies</u>. Photographic and facsimile copies of such signed counterparts may be used in lieu of the originals of this agreement for any purpose.
