12 Year Old Charged with School Threat and Possessing a Knife in School

Mount Clemens, MI - Today, a 12 year old juvenile was charged and had a preliminary hearing in connection with threatening a student with a knife at a Richmond Middle School.

The 12 year old juvenile was charged with Intentional Threat to Commit Act of Violence Against a School, School Employees or Students (1 Year Misdemeanor,) and Possessing a Weapon in a Weapon Free School Zone (93 Day Misdemeanor.)

The juvenile's preliminary hearing was in front of Macomb County Circuit Court Chief Referee Linda Harrison. The Referee Harrison set a \$500 personal bond and upon release the juvenile is restricted to his home. His next court date is Wednesday, April 5, 2023 at 8:30 am before Macomb County Circuit Court Referee Stone.

"All threats in schools need to stop now! Bringing any type of weapon to school is illegal and my office will charge it all day, every day," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.

The Macomb County Prosecutor's office represents the people. We are committed to achieving justice and following the laws of the State of Michigan. All that are accused of a crime are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
