

Subject: Inspection of the Drain Under I-696

The Center Line Relief & Branches Drain is an enclosed stormwater drain constructed in the early 1970's that runs along Van Dyke in the City of Warren. The Drain consists of a 84-inch diameter RCP section that crosses beneath the I-696 expressway, see attached map for reference. The MCPWO has determined that an inspection of this Drain is due, specifically as it relates to the location, a failure of this drain in this location would have severe impacts to I-696. The drain has not been inspected since it was constructed based on records available to MCPWO staff.

The increase of funding for the County's Drain Match Program in 2023 has allowed the MCPWO to expand the program to include enclosed stormwater drains. MCPWO evaluated areas critical in nature that should be inspected. This inspection is selected for the Macomb County Drain Match Program. Discussions with the City of Warren Engineering Department to allocate City funds toward this inspection are ongoing. The MCPWO decided to move forward with the inspection utilizing existing drain funds and County Drain Match funds. Depending on the results if the inspection, future funds allocated by the City will either be applied to this inspection or toward repairs or sediment removal identified during the inspection.

A team consisting of AEW and Doetsch Environmental Services was selected to provide the services required to facilitate an inspection of this section of the drain. The inspection, oversight and final reporting is estimated to cost \$58,514, cost summary is attached for reference.


