- Orders \$300 or less—Full payment due when placing orders.
- Orders over \$300—50% of balance due when placing order, full balance due at time of pickup.
- \$25 service fee for cancellations. *Cancellations of orders are subject to restocking surcharge expenses passed on from the nursery suppliers.
- No cancellations allowed after March 31, 2017. Orders not picked up on designated pickup dates/locations will not be refunded.
- Add your orders carefully! Adding errors with overpayment up to \$10 will be considered a donation to the SCD.
- Plant material is primarily bare root stock and perishable. District liability ceases when trees/plants are picked up.
- Sizes (height) listed are provided by our nursery suppliers. Actual size may vary based on nursery grading & growth.
