

DELTA DENTAL INTEGRATED SPECIAL CARE CLINIC

Providing care for patients ages 16 and up, the Special Care Clinic is designed to accommodate patient care where standard dental operations can be challenging. This clinic has been designed to provide care for patients with the following types of conditions:

- Cerebral palsy, development/intellectual disabilities
- Autism Spectrum Disorder (mild to moderate)
- Acquired cognitive disabilities: dementia, Traumatic Brain Injury, progressive neuro logic disorders such as Parkinson's disease, Huntington's disease
- Physical disabilities that limit mobility, vision or hearing
- Chronic medical problems such as diabetes, hypertension, heart disease, renal failure, COPD
- Immunologically-mediated diseases such as Sjogren's syndrome
- Chronic pain syndromes

FOR REFERRING CLINICIANS

Medical Complexity

- Do not require blood products in order to have dental treatment
- Do not require continuous physiologic monitoring during dental treatment
- Do not require dental treatment to be provided under iv sedation or GA
- Can ambulate to the clinic via wheelchair, or with other mobility aids (not a gurney)

Behavioral Complexity

- Can tolerate dental procedures performed in ambulatory setting
- Can cooperate during care provided under local anesthesia with/without nitrous oxide sedation
- Do not pose a physical risk to themselves or others, with reasonable modifications to treatment provision

Who are the Providers?

- General Dentist with experience and commitment to patients with special needs
- Dental Hygienist with experience and commitment to patients with special needs
- Dental and dental hygiene students with special interest/focus on Special Care Dentistry
