

Subject: Fund Transfer Request – Rohrbeck Extension Drain Maintenance

The Roseville Storm Drain Improvement Program No. 3 (1998) and Roseville Catch Basin Repair Program No. 4 (2001) Drainage Districts were formed as part of a storm sewer improvement projects in the City of Roseville. At the completion of the projects each Drainage District had unused surplus funds that have remained in the Drain Account.

The Roseville Storm Drain Improvement Program No. 3 account has approximately \$15,857 and the Roseville Catch Basin Repair Program No. 4 account has approximately \$204,347.

The Rohrbeck Extension Drain, which is in the City of Roseville is currently in need of a significant maintenance project. The MCPWO staff have identified these two Drainage Districts as a funding source to facilitate the current and future maintenance needs in the City of Roseville Drainage Districts.

The recommendation is that the Roseville Storm Drain Improvement Program No. 3 & Roseville Catch Basin Repair Program No. 4 Drain Drainage District authorize the transfer of all funds into the Rohrbeck Extension Drain account. The exact amount of the transfers will be determined based on the final interest accrued on the amounts indicated above.
