MCR 8.111(B) provides that all cases must be assigned by lot, unless a different system is adopted by local court administrative order. Since it is in the interests of justice to vary from the general rule in particular types of cases, all superintending control, forfeiture and mandamus actions shall be assigned to the Chief Judge of the Macomb County Circuit Court upon filing and not by blind draw.
