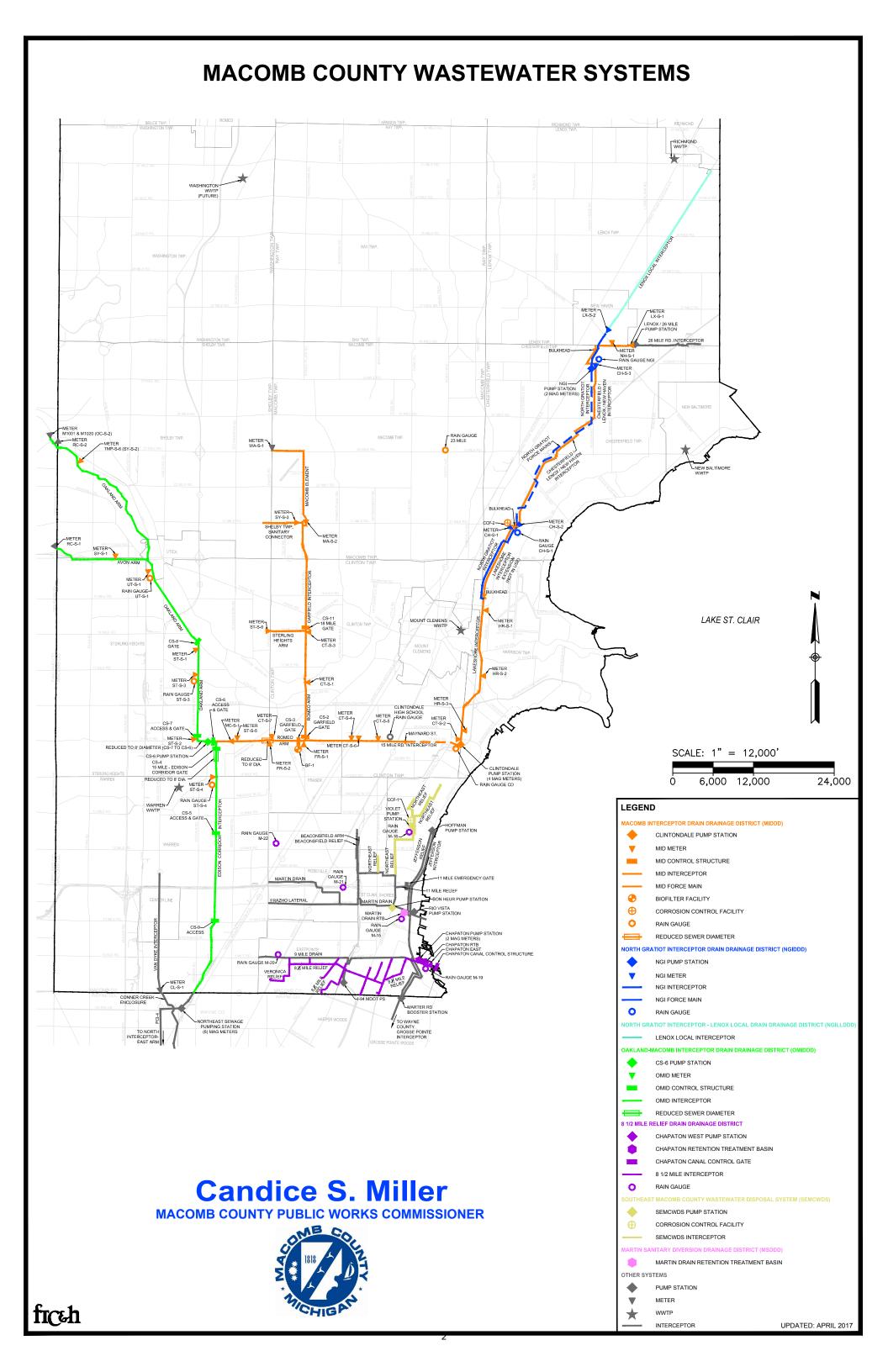

Subject: Construction Projects Status Updates for March 2021 Board Meeting

The following provides a status update for construction work completed within the 8 ½ Mile Relief Drain Drainage District (8MRDDD) and Martin Sanitary Diversion Drain District (MSDDD) for the previous month within both districts.

Chapaton Pump & Screen Project

Contractor: J.F. Cavanaugh

Engineering Consultant: HRC

Project Description:

This project consists of the replacement of the influent bar screens, addition of a third intermediate pump, and replacement of the manhole covers located at level B3 within the Chapaton Pump Station. The bar screens have reached the end of their useful life and are critical to protecting the pumps to not allow large objects to enter the wet well. The third intermediate pump is being installed as a redundant measure for dewatering of the in-system storage increased stored flows. The manhole covers are being replaced with pressure rated sealed covers to allow staff to raise the operating level of the wet well by 6 feet. This will provide approximately 3 million gallons of additional storage and will provide additional pumping capacity for the stormwater pumps.

Significant project tasks that have occurred over the past month:

- 1. Third intermediate pump has been installed and put through start-up testing.
- 2. New manhole covers have been tested and had minor leaks. Contractor has submitted a plan to correct the issue and MCPWO has approved.
 - o This work has been completed and MCPWO will test during the next rain event.
- 3. All new piping has been painted.

4. Punch list has been developed for close-out tasks and work has begun on that.

Chapaton & Martin Disinfection Replacement Project

Contractor: Weiss Construction

Engineering Consultant: Wade Trim

Project Description:

This project consists of the complete replacement of the disinfection systems at Chapaton and Martin. Macomb County Public Works Office (MCPWO) staff identified that a critical capital improvement need for the Chapaton and Martin RTB's was the replacement of the disinfection systems. These are systems that were installed in approximately 1978 and have exceeded the end of their useful life. MCPWO staff has worked diligently to keep the existing disinfection pumps in service as they are prone to failure and require expensive, difficult to obtain parts. The project involves all disinfection chemical feed pumps, new electrical controls and VFDs, and new disinfection and sample piping within the Chapaton RTB.

Significant project tasks that have occurred over the past month:

- 1. Poured seven (7) new concrete pump pads to support hose pumps Chapaton 5; Martin 2.
- 2. Hung 3" recirculation piping from ceiling in Storage Tank Room in the Chapaton East Building
- 3. Set new Bredel hose pumps on concrete pads at Chapaton
- 4. Installed new FRP uni-strut supports and piping from hose pumps to wall. Note: existing disinfection system was not taken out of service. Full demo of the existing system and final piping will be installed within a 24 hour period to limit down-time.

Chapaton Lab & Mezzanine Project

Project Description:

This project consists of relocating the Lab to the Chapaton East Building to allow for the complete overhaul of the Mezzanine level within the Chapaton Pump Station which includes new crew quarters, conference room, kitchen area, and SCADA control room. All areas were original to the facility dating back to 1968 and in need of improvements.

Significant project tasks that have occurred over the past month:

- 1. Demolished existing wall tiles, drop ceiling, door, electrical, and lockers in East Building
- 2. Installed new electrical, plumbing, and drywall in East Building (all building inspections passed)
- 3. Installed new metal laboratory casework
- 4. Began preliminary demolition of Mezzanine level then performed abatement of existing previously identified hazardous materials.
- 5. Removed existing interior masonry walls on the Mezzanine level

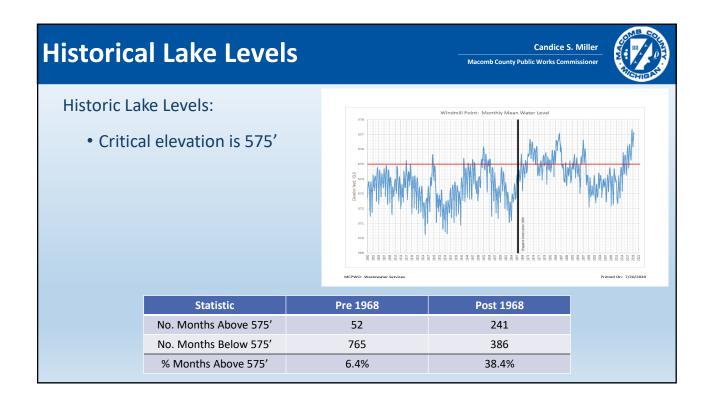

- 128% increase for SE Michigan

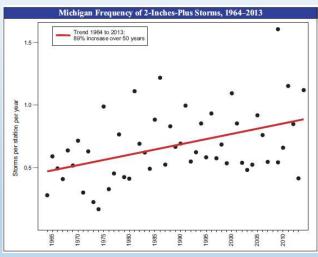

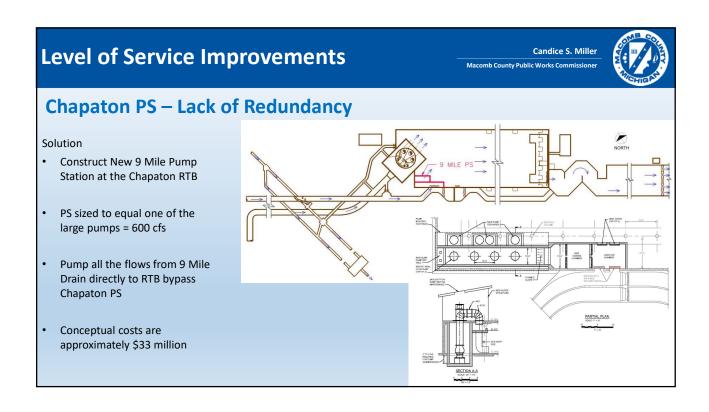
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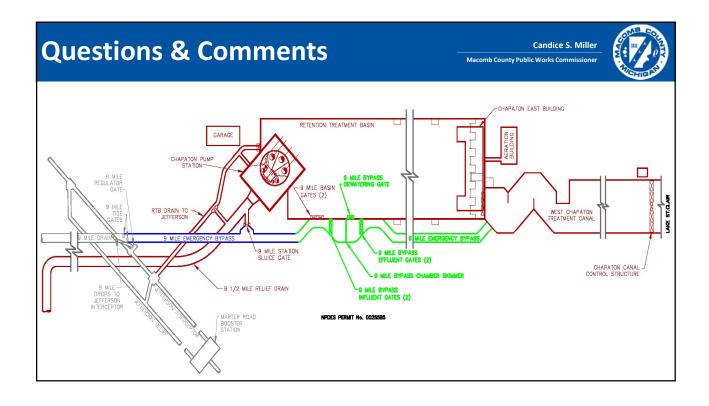
10-Year, 24-Hour (3.27 inches) Design Storm:

Subject: Chapaton Basin & 9 Mile Emergency Bypass Sewer Structural Repairs- Construction Contract

Recommendation

The Chapaton Retention Basin (CHA-RTB) and 9 Mile Emergency Bypass (9EB) have underwent several inspections over the past few years. As part of the SAW grant for the 8 ½ Mile District, the 9EB was inspected which was in 2017. The CHA-RTB was then inspected in 2019 as part of the SE Macomb As-Needed Engineering contract. These inspections identified key areas that require structural repairs. Below are several images showing some of the areas that will be addressed as part of this work.

In the 2020/2021 budget for the 8 ½ Mile Relief Drain Drainage District, there was \$1.25 million allocated for this project to make the necessary structural repairs.

In November 2020, MCPWO contracted with Fishbeck and NTH to develop the plans and specifications to make the necessary structural repairs as part of the SE Macomb As-Needed contract. Once this task was complete, MCPWO posted the plans and specifications to MITN to go through a competitive bidding process for construction. The engineering estimate for this project is \$789,000.

On February 26, 2021, MCPWO received two bids for the structural rehab project. Those bids were as follows.

- Pullman SST, Inc. = \$736,950
- DRV Contractors = \$847,495

NTH performed a bid tabulation and the apparent low bidder, Pullman SST Inc., is qualified to perform the work and was the recommended bidder. MCPWO agrees with this recommendation and is recommending to the board that the contract in the amount of \$736,950 is awarded to Pullman SST, Inc.

One item of note for this contract is that this work is based on unit rates of the actual repaired quantities. The plans were developed using engineering best judgement for what quantities may be needed but it may be required to perform repairs that can exceed or be under the quantities as listed in the contract. This work will have full-time construction observation so that quantities and repairs will be tracked closely. MCPWO will monitor the contract repairs and will update the board as the project progresses.

Dear Mr. Astorino:

The purpose of this letter is to offer our recommendation to award a contract to the most responsive bidder to perform the Work for Macomb County Project Number WWS-2-21-001: Chapaton Basin and 9 Mile Emergency Bypass Sewer Structural Repairs for the 8-1/2 Mile Relief Drain Drainage District. As you are aware, the Project Documents were advertised on the Michigan Inter-governmental Trade Network (MITN) and the scheduled bid opening was performed at the Chapaton Basin office on Friday, February 26, 2021 at 2:00 PM.

Immediately prior to the bid opening, bids were received from two contractors – Pullman SST, Inc. and DRV Contractors, LLC. We have tabulated the contractor's bid results and highlighted the lowest unit cost for each of the bid items for comparison. Based on the bid amounts, Pullman SST bid the lower number at \$736,950.00 vs. \$847,495.00 for DRV. The tabulation is included with this letter for your review. We also included a breakdown from the original conceptual Engineer's Opinion of Probable Costs in the table for your information.

Based on review of the information provided in the bids, both contractors are qualified to perform the Work identified in the Project Documents. They both included bid bonds, acknowledged the Addendum in the documents, and provided the requested information with one exception. DRV provided project history for six projects, including key staff, but did not provide individual resumes for their proposed key staff in their bid documents.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on their Bid costs and related information, we recommend awarding a contract to Pullman SST, Inc. for a total not to exceed amount of \$736,950.00. As this contract is based on unit rates of the actual repaired quantities, we anticipate some of the final bid items may be adjusted within the not-to-exceed budget during execution of the contract. Because of this, it is important to have construction contract administration services including field oversight to document and quantity the repair quantities.



Upon the 8-1/2 Mile Drain Drainage District Board's approval of the above contract amount, we will work with you to provide the necessary Contract Documents as identified in the Issued for Bid Documents.

The Chapaton Retention Basin (CHA-RTB) and 9 Mile Emergency Bypass (9EB) have underwent several inspections over the past few years. As part of the SAW grant for the 8 ½ Mile District, the 9EB was inspected which was in 2017. The CHA-RTB was then inspected in 2019 as part of the SE Macomb As-Needed Engineering contract. These inspections identified key areas that require structural repairs.

In the 2020/2021 budget for the 8 ½ Mile Relief Drain Drainage District, there was \$1.25 million allocated for this project to make the necessary structural repairs.

In November 2020, MCPWO contracted with Fishbeck and NTH to develop the plans and specifications to make the necessary structural repairs as part of the SE Macomb As-Needed contract. Once this task was complete, MCPWO posted the plans and specifications to MITN to go through a competitive bidding process for construction. The engineering estimate for this project is \$789,000.

MCPWO recommended a contractor for this work in a prior memo. This memo is to recommend the construction administration services of Fishbeck and NTH. The majority of the construction administration will go through NTH but since Fishbeck is the prime for the as-needed contract they will provide project management support.

The construction administration contract will include some of the following items.

- Contractor submittal and request for information review.
- Field observation to properly track repair quantities and ensure that the contractor is making the appropriate repairs. This task is very important as this project is based on unit rates of actual repair quantities.
- Pay application review
- Record drawing development

The not-to-exceed cost from Fishbeck and NTH is \$128,732. This will be handled as a change order to the existing as-needed engineering contract. The costs for this work are in line with what we would expect especially when you take into account the full-time inspection and working in a confined space.

At your request, Fishbeck and NTH Consultants, Ltd. (NTH) are pleased to submit this proposal for professional engineering services as part of the 8½ Mile Relief Drain Drainage District (8RDDD) As-Needed Engineering Services. While Fishbeck is the lead engineer for the As-Needed Engineering Services, NTH will take the lead in providing Construction Contract Administration (CCA) services for Task 1.O. Fishbeck will provide overall project management (PM) services.

Attached is NTH's proposal to complete the CCA services requested.

We propose to complete the scope of services described herein on a time-and-materials with a not to exceed fee. The estimated fee is detailed as follows:

At your request, NTH Consultants, Ltd. (NTH) has prepared this additional scope of services to be performed under the 8-1/2 Mile Relief Drain Drainage District As-Needed Engineering Services Contract. The additional scope for Task 10 under this contract will include Construction Contract Administration (CCA) services during repairs to the Chapaton Retention Treatment Basin (RTB) and Phase I of the 9 Mile Emergency Bypass Sewer (9EB Sewer) which were performed under Tasks 1.A and 1.B of this contract. The repair contract also includes a point repair within the 8-1/2 Mile Relief Drain.

It may be necessary to revisit the budget when the design nears completion to account for many additional months of coordination and work created by the design schedule extension needed to support the inflatable manufacturers.

The schedule for 100% documents is delayed due to community reviews but is still tracking well ahead of the vendor's testing schedule.

Schedule:

The 90% design schedule was met by Tetra Tech but the bidding schedule is being delayed by the inflatable vendor. Meeting the revised bidding and construction schedule is contingent upon successful scale model testing of the inflatable sewer gate (ISG) being completed by Arcon / Mecan-Hydro. Planning Commission approvals are also required from both St. Clair Shores and Eastpointe, and these may also impact when permits will be obtained and when public meetings will be held. Manufacturer testing remains the critical path.

Next task or action items.

- Submit to Planning Commissions for St. Clair Shores and Eastpointe (only after receiving authority to do that from MCPWO).
- Submit for EGLE preliminary review concurrently with the Planning Commissions (only after receiving authority to do that from MCPWO).
- 3. Update design drawings for vent shielding/disguises based on direction from MCPWO.
- 4. Coordinate with St. Clair Shores for the park amenities and other coordination items.
- 5. Coordinate with utilities (electrical, gas, water, stormwater, sewer, and telecommunications).

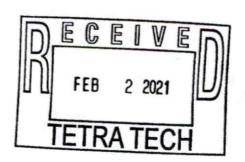

- Continued coordination with Arcon regarding details for the inflatable sewer gate (ISG) design.
- Communicated with both St. Clair Shores and Eastpointe regarding their review requirements at this stage.
- · Facilitated meetings between Arcon and MCPWO for the inflatable sewer gate (ISG) scale model testing phase.
- Provided additional vent shielding/disguise options to aid MCPWO with decision making.
- Reviewed MCPWO's 90% design drawing comments and updated two drawing sheets ahead of community review submittals.

Opportunities for cost avoidance or added value.

Impediments, roadblocks, assistance needed.

Ongoing support from MCPWO is needed to solicit direction from St. Clair Shores regarding park amenities and other miscellaneous issues. Backing up to change design features may not be accommodated in the project budget. A meeting with the St. Clair Shores Parks department has been scheduled for March 3rd to gather feedback and direction.

Assistance from MCPWO is needed to confirm if new leadership in Eastpointe requires and easement for the building construction in Beaconsfield.

Direction from MCPWO is needed regarding the desired aesthetics for the venting sites. Depending on the request, it may require one-off design so that a specialty fabrication shop will be able to manufacture the vents.

MCPWO previously suggested that utility relocation occur prior to letting the general contract. If that is to occur, Tetra Tech needs direction to start and advice on how these relocations will be funded.

Change (or potential change) of scope items or customer concession. (Details on attached Request to Change Authorization)

It may be necessary to revisit the budget when the design nears completion to account for many additional months of coordination and work created by the design schedule extension needed to support the inflatable manufacturers.

The schedule for 100% documents is delayed due to vendor's testing schedule.

Schedule:

The 90% design schedule was met by Tetra Tech but the bidding schedule is being delayed by the inflatable vendor. Meeting the revised bidding and construction schedule is contingent upon successful scale model testing of the inflatable sewer gate (ISG) being completed by Arcon / Mecan-Hydro. Community approvals are also required from both St. Clair Shores and Eastpointe, and these may also impact when permits will be obtained and when public meetings will be held. Manufacturer testing remains the critical path.

Next task or action items.

- 1. Submissions for Planning Commission and/or Administrative Review by St. Clair Shores and the City of Eastpointe.
- 2. Assist MCPWO with submission of Part 41 Permit and review by EGLE concurrently with the community reviews.
- 3. Coordinate with St. Clair Shores for the park amenities and other coordination items.
- 4. Coordinate with utilities (electrical, gas, water, stormwater, sewer, and telecommunications), if requested.
- 5. Coordinate with Arcon for inflatable sewer gate design.
- Update design drawings for vent shielding/disguises based on direction from MCPWO.
- 7. Continue preparation of other permitting documentation and reports.
