



The meeting was opened to public participation, then closed, there being no comments from the public.

Mr. Downing is recommending LJ Construction for drain maintenance contract authorization on the Rohrbeck Extension Drain in the City of Roseville. Maintenance includes bank stabilization, channel realignment, and miscellaneous repair of discharge connections. The location and cost summary are as follows; Erin Street \$13,695.00, Famous Dave's \$59,550.00, and Red Roof Inn \$60,495.00. MDOT will be funding separate repairs to their drainage. The total proposed maintenance cost is \$133,740.00. He recommends an approximate contingency of \$30,000 for unforeseen circumstances that may arise during construction. The Rohrbeck currently has \$14,890 available in the drain account. Mr. Downing presented some pictures of the areas that the work will be performed. Ms. Klinefelt asked if there will be traffic disruptions while the work is being performed. Mr. Bednar answered no. The board discussed adding an additional \$20,000 for possible overages and needed plantings.

A motion was made by Mr. Santo, supported by Mr. Haugh to approve a maintenance contract with LJ Construction for the not-to-exceed amount of \$185,000.00 and to authorize payment to LJ Construction upon completion of the work.

Subject: Drain Maintenance Update - LJ Construction

The MCPWO is happy to report the completion of the maintenance project on the Rohrbeck Extension Drain in the City of Roseville. The maintenance work included bank stabilization, channel re-alignment and miscellaneous repair of discharge/lateral connections. The locations include the area south of 13 Mile Road between the Gratiot I-94 Connector and west bound I-94, the area east of Little Mack and west of I-94 and the area west of Little Mack off Erin Street.

The Board authorized LJ Construction to perform the required maintenance for the not-to-exceed amount of \$185,000 at the August Drain Board meeting. The total cost incurred with LJ Construction is \$199,558.40 which includes additional work identified by MCPWO personnel during the course of the work. This amount also include repair of a MDOT lateral connection, an invoice will be sent to MDOT for this repair. A summary of the total cost is shown below:

- Famous Dave's Location \$81,500.00
- Red Roof Inn Location \$60,495.00
- Erin Street Location \$13,695.00
- Extra Work \$27,341.40
- MDOT Lateral Tap Repair \$16,527.00

Since MDOT elected to have LJ Construction perform the lateral connection repair, a change order to the LJ Construction agreement is required. The amount of the change order is \$14,558.40.

Additionally, there was fencing along the drain that required repair. This work was performed by Taylor Made Fence at the direction of MCPWO for the total amount of \$3,100.

The total net cost to the Rohrbeck Extension Drain for the maintenance work performed by \Box Construction and fence repair by Taylor Made Fence is \$186,131.40. The Drain account is estimated to have approximately \$46,495 remaining for future maintenance work. The MCPWO is currently working with MDOT officials for an additional contribution to the overall maintenance cost. Any additional funds received from MDOT will be transferred to the Rohrbeck Extension Drain account for future maintenance needs.

The recommendation is that the Rohrbeck Extension Drain Drainage District Board authorize the Board's Chair to execute the LJ Construction Change Order No. 1 for the amount of \$14,558.40.

This was the Problem



- Severe erosion at several spots which was in danger of undermining I-94
- MDOT's catch basin from I-94 had completely failed





- We needed to straighten out the drain
- We needed to back fill the side along I-94
- We needed to armor the sides of the drain with geotech fabric and puzzled in rip-rap for a long term solution
- We needed to move money from existing drain accounts so that Roseville did not have any out of pocket expense






Infrastructure Disaster Averted Along I-94 in Roseville

- City of Roseville DPW staff notified MCPWO of erosion this summer
- Our partners had been monitoring the situation

 Rapid erosion reached within 25 yards of Freeway. MDOT's I-94 drainage failures were within 10 feet of I-94




Project Summary
