

Subject: Meadow Ridge Subdivision 54-inch Repair

The Macomb County Public Works Office (MCPWO) staff were made aware of an issue with the 54-inch pipe and end-sections at the Meadow Ridge subdivision access drive on the Shelby Consolidated Drain – Northwest Section Newland Branch.

Based on an inspection of the drain the repair consists of removal and reset of the 54-inch end-section, removal and reset of 54-inch RCP storm sewer, placement of rip-rap at both end-sections, point up of existing joints and restoration. The MCPWO solicited quotations from three contractors to perform the necessary repairs. The table below summarizes the quotations:

Contractor	Cost
Teltow Contracting, Inc.	\$18,171.00
T.R. Pieprzak Co., Inc.	\$22,748.00
Cortis Brothers Trucking & Excavating	\$21,900.00

The MCPWO coordinated with Shelby Township to contribute toward the repair as part of the Macomb County Community Match Program which they agreed to contribute half of the low bid (\$18,171) in the amount of \$9,080. The table below summarizes the cost allocation for the repair cost:






