Fingerprinting applicants will speed up CPL process

The Macomb County Clerk's Office has made it easier for residents to apply for Concealed Pistol Licenses (CPL).

Clerk Anthony Forlini announced the vital records department and the Clerk's Office have streamlined procedures by not only processing appointments on the same day as

requested but also adding the service of fingerprinting, which prevents the need to set up a separate appointment at the Sheriff's Office.

"Our group in the CPL Department is adding tremendous value for our residents that is hard to find in government agencies," Forlini said. "At one time last year, it was taking over a month just to get an appointment. Today we are processing between 30-100 CPL applications a day with same-day appointments."

"The days of taking time out of your day to drive from office to office for your CPL are over. Time matters, and the residents of Macomb County deserve stellar service." Forlini added. "Not only do we have this enhanced benefit, but we have sped up the process so we are able to do same-day appointments."
