The free expos will provide information on infant safety such as best sleep practices, safe car seat installations and resources for new and expecting parents. A catered meal will be provided, several local vendors will be present and participants will have a chance to win prizes valued up to \$200.

Supported through a grant from the Michigan Department of Community Health and Human Services, the infant safety expos will help promote infant safe sleep practices and reduce infant mortality in Macomb County and throughout the state.

The campaign's goal is to build community awareness of the importance of placing infants on their backs and in a safe sleep environment and to educate advocates that will spread the safe sleep message throughout Macomb County.
