Opportunity knocks! Investment open house planned for downtown Mount Clemens

New construction, growing enrollment at Oakland University's Anton/Frankel Center and increasing demand for walkable spaces makes Mount Clemens a community ripe with opportunities.

Macomb County Department of Planning & Economic Development is partnering with city officials and area business leaders to host a tour of available buildings in the downtown area.

The event will take place from 2-4 p.m. on Wednesday, July 15. It will begin at Bath City Bistro, 75 Macomb Place and end at Three Blind Mice, 101 N. Main Street.

"Many people think of downtown Mount Clemens as a hub for dining and entertainment," said Vicky Rad, deputy director of the department. "While that is still true, we are also seeing an infusion of technologically based businesses that are taking advantage of the city's affordability and an ability to attract and retain talent that wants to work in a vibrant community."

Overall, more than a dozen properties suitable for office or retail space will be featured on the tour. Also offered is a rare opportunity to tour the Macomb Music Theater, one of the featured available properties.
