Man Guilty of First Degree Murder

Mount Clemens, MI - Today, 28 year old Dangelo Hubbard of Detroit was found guilty on all charges in the death of Lisa Marrone from Roseville after a five day jury trial by Assistant Prosecutors Anthony Sorentino and Sian Hengeveld.

On Friday, February 4, 2022, Dangelo Hubbard drove to Lisa Marrone's residence in a stolen vehicle. He stabbed her over 75 times and inflicted blunt force trauma to her head resulting in her death. The next day Hubbard returned to the victim's residence and set it on fire.

The jury convicted Dangelo Hubbard of First Degree Premeditated Murder (Life without Parole Felony), Felony Murder (Life without Parole Felony) First Degree Arson (Life Felony) and Receiving and Concealing Stolen Property of a Motor vehicle Second Offense (10 Year felony.)

Hubbard will be sentenced on Thursday, June 1, 2023 at 9:30 am in front of Macomb County Circuit Court Judge Richard Caretti.

"Thank you to the Roseville Police Department and the Roseville Fire Department for their thorough investigation in this case. My heart goes out to the family who can begin the process of closure and healing after this terrible tragedy," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.
