Man Arraigned on 12 Charges in Connection with Assault with Intent to Murder

Mount Clemens, MI - Today, 30 year old Trevion Terelle Smith-Johnson of Detroit was arraigned in connection with a shooting.

It is alleged that on Monday, May 8, 2023, Trevion Terelle Smith-Johnson ambushed the victim at his home in Eastpointe. Smith-Johnson pointed a handgun at the victim, and demanded everything he had. When the victim refused, Smith-Johnson shot at him. The victim took cover and Smith-Johnson shot at him four additional times. Smith-Johnson was apprehended shortly after fleeing on foot.

Trevion Terelle Smith-Johnson is charged with Assault with Intent to Murder (life felony), Assault with Intent to rob while Armed (life felony), Armed Robbery (life felony), Felon in Possession of Firearms (five-year felony), Felon in Possession of Ammunition (five-year felony), Felonious Assault with a Dangerous Weapon (four-year felony), and six counts of Felony Firearm (a mandatory two-year prison sentence for each count.)

Smith-Johnson was arraigned in the 38th Eastpointe District Court by Magistrate Mark Makoski who set bond at \$1,500,000.00 cash/surety, upon release the defendant must wear a steel cuff tether, be on house arrest, receive a mental health assessment, and refrain from alcohol and drugs.

The probable cause hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, June 6, 2023 at 8:00 am and the preliminary exam is scheduled for Tuesday, June 13, 2023 at 8:00 am in the 38th Eastpointe District Court.

“As Macomb County Prosecutor, I will uphold the law and hold accountable those who choose violence. The Macomb County Prosecutor’s Office will continue to partner with our local law enforcement to ensure all who are convicted face the proper consequences and punishment for their actions. Our office will continue to work tirelessly to ensure our citizens of Macomb County are safe and that justice will be imposed on those who attempt to disrupt our family’s security and safety,” said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.

The Macomb County Prosecutor’s office represents the people. We are committed to achieving justice and following the laws of the State of Michigan. All that are accused of a crime are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
