Treasurer's Office Services



Lawrence Rocca Macomb County Treasurer

By law the Macomb County Treasurer is the custodian of all County funds. The Office of County Treasurer and its duties are established by the state constitution. County funds under the Treasurer's jurisdiction include drainage districts, County road improvement projects, Circuit Court, Veteran's Trust and Delinquent Tax Revolving Fund.

The Delinquent Tax Revolving Fund purchased approximately \$41.7 million in delinquent property taxes in 2015. This timely payment of operating capital provides school districts and local communities reliable revenue to budget.

Also, the Treasurer is responsible for accounting all the County's revenues, investments, securities and funds in financial institutions.

Other duties of the Treasurer include serving on the employee retirement system, intermediate trust boards, the County Elections Commission, Appointment Commission, Plat Board and Building Authority.



➤ Public Sector

The Public Sector section assists county taxpayers. They are also responsible for certifying taxes and legal descriptions for deeds and land contracts. Tax credit information for seniors, veterans, and the disabled are also available through this office.

➤ Finance and Bookkeeping

As the investment officer for County funds, the Treasurer uses sound banking and investment practices to ensure that Macomb County taxpayers are realizing the highest yield for their tax dollars with the lowest level of risk.

The Macomb County tax rate is one of the lowest in Michigan, so investment returns are essential. In balancing the County's budget, losses on investments must be avoided. The Treasurer's Office invests County funds wisely to attain a maximum rate of return, while preserving and protecting capital in the County's overall portfolio.

Safety is always our first priority. To ensure the safety and security of our tax dollars, our office reconciles the County's many bank accounts daily. State Tax Commission, Michigan Tax Tribunal and local Board of Review changes are processed by the bookkeeping section.

➤ Tax Settlement Office

The Tax Settlement Officer finalizes the tax rolls with city, township, and village treasurers. Here we are responsible for completing the state report that calculates funding for Macomb County Schools.

➤ Land File

This department manages more than 360,000 individual real estate parcels in Macomb County. It maintains: legal descriptions, taxpayer identification, assessment information, delinquent tax data, property line drawings, plotting new subdivisions, and aerial photographs of the County.

➤ Delinquent Property Division

The Delinquent Property Division began its operation in 1990. The department is contracted by 26 local communities in Macomb County to collect their delinquent personal property taxes. The department has collected \$21.5 million in taxes since 2010, of which \$8.7 million has gone to local school districts.

Our staff works diligently with real estate property owners to determine potential sources of assistance and develop a plan to help them meet their obligations. We want all residents to Keep Macomb Their Home!
