COURT CLOSURE FOR BUILDING CLEANING


IT IS ORDERED:

This Administrative Order is issued in accordance with MCR 8.110(C). The purpose of this Order is to close the business offices of the Courts to the public in order to thoroughly clean and disinfect the building, upon approval by the State Court Administrative Office.

The business offices of 42-1 District Court will be closed on Friday, October 16, 2020. All in-custody arraignments and emergency matters (including emergency filings) will be conducted while the Courts' business offices are closed to the public.

Notice of the court closure and of how emergency matters and filings shall be accomplished during the closing shall be given to the public, the Courts' funding unit, and other affected agencies and officials. Notice shall include a sign posted at the Courts.
