



## **Service Request Source**




In the month of December, 48 incoming requests regarding traffic signals were received.

## Service Request by Dept.









## **GOVDELIVERY NOTIFICATIONS**

In the month of December, the TOC sent out 11 GovDelivery notifications, and increased the number of recipients from 2,218 to 2,333 receiving notifications.

GovDelivery is a tool to notify Macomb County motorists of any incident blocking at least one lane of traffic or causing traffic issues. The notifications are sent after an incident has been verified.
