Macomb Prosecutor's Office Reissues Charges in Connection with Thanksgiving Day Shooting

Mount Clemens, MI - The Macomb County Prosecutor's Office reissued charges against a Warren man in connection with a Thanksgiving Day shooting.

The Macomb County Prosecutor's Office charged Michael Kamal Sinnawi with assault with intent to murder (a felony punishable by up to life,) discharge of a firearm from a vehicle causing injury (15 year felony), possession of a firearm (5 year felony), and two counts of felony firearm (2 year felony) from a November 25, 2023 shooting. The criminal charges relating to the shooting were dismissed on Tuesday, January 31, 2023 after civilian witnesses did not show up to court at his preliminary examination.

Today, the Macomb County Prosecutor's Office has reissued charges and arraigned Sinnawi on carrying a concealed weapon (5 year felony), felon in possession of a firearm (5 year felony) and felony firearm (2 year mandatory felony). Bond was set at \$750,000 cash/surety only. The defendant remains in custody. The Probable Cause Hearing is scheduled February 14, 2023 at 9:00am and the Preliminary Examination is scheduled for February 21, 2023 at 9:00am.

"Unfortunately some witnesses and victims do not show up to court because they may struggle with the thought of reliving the traumatic event or the stress and anxiety of court. But in this case, we have reissued charges to keep the community safe. We will continue to make every effort to support the victims and witnesses and encourage them to be part of this process," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido
