Eastpointe Mayor Arraigned

Mount Clemens, MI - Today, the Mayor of Eastpointe was arraigned in Mt. Clemens District Court.

Mayor Monique Owens allegedly fraudulently applied for a grant under the "CARES ACT" in November 2020. Owens received \$10,000 from the Macomb County grant.

The Mayor was charged with False Pretenses \$1,000.00 or More but Less Than \$20,000.00 (5 year felony.) Owens was arraigned in 41B District Court. Magistrate Ryan Zemke set a \$10,000.00 personal bond. The defendant's next court date is Tuesday, April 11, 2023 at 1:30pm.

"I will not shy away from public corruption cases. This is not the first time my office has authorized charges involving a public servant during my two years as a county prosecutor. I ran for office to clean up public corruption," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.
