Detroit Woman Charged and Arraigned in Road Rage Incident

Mount Clemens, MI - A 26 year old Detroit woman was charged and arraigned in connection with a road rage incident while driving her brother to school.

Carmelita Frye was driving her mother's black Dodge Journey and allegedly fired shots at another vehicle. Centerline Police responded to the alleged road rage incident and attempted a traffic stop. Frye fled the police and entered the Centerline Preparatory Academy parking lot, weaving in and out of pedestrians and cars. Eventually, Frye stopped the vehicle and police were able to arrest her.

Frye was charged with Fleeing and Eluding Third Degree (5 Year Felony,) Carrying a Concealed Weapon (5 Year Felony,) and Felony Firearm (Mandatory 2 Year Felony.) On Tuesday, March 7, 2023, Carmelita Frye was arraigned in Centerline District Court. District Court Chief Judge John Chmura set bond at \$100,000.00 cash/surety, no 10% and, upon release, Frye must wear a steel cuff tether and have no weapons.

"Gun crimes are increasing in Macomb County and I will charge them all," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido
