Guilty in First Degree Murder Case

Mount Clemens, MI - Macomb County Assistant Prosecutor Cory Newman conducted a five day jury trial and last night a Macomb County jury convicted Jerel McCrary, 32 years old, of Roseville on all charges.

On Friday, March 25, 2022, Jerel McCrary sent a text to his ex-fiance threatening to kill everyone she knows. Then he went to her mother's home and video-called her. McCrary shot and killed her Mother, Cedic Fields, and Uncle, Kenny Burks, while on the call.

McCrary was charged with two counts of First Degree Murder (Life without Parole,) and two counts of Felony Firearm (Two Year Felony.)

Jerel McCary will be sentenced on Thursday, May 23, 2023 at 9 am in front of Circuit Court Judge James Maceroni.

"This unspeakable act of violence it is a total disregard for human lifes. This can only be described as the actions of a coward. I am thankful to the Eastpointe Police Department for their thorough investigation and the Macomb County jury for coming back with a guilty verdict," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.
