Man arraigned for assault at Cub Scout meeting

Mount Clemens, MI - Yesterday, 26 year old Tyrone Sledge of Warren was arraigned in connection with an altercation at a cub scout meeting in Warren.

It is alleged that on Tuesday, April 18, 2023, Tyreshia Sledge and the victim got into an argument over a parking spot at Roose Elementary when they were arriving for a Cub Scout Meeting. Tyreshia contacted her brother, Tyrone Sledge, about the incident. Tyrone Sledge arrived at the meeting and spoke with his sister who pointed at the victim. Tyrone approached the victim and punched him twice in the head. The victim was admitted into the hospital.

Tyrone Sledge is charged with Assault with Intent to do Great Bodily Harm Less Than Murder (10 Year Felony.) Sledge was arraigned in front of Warren District Court Judge Steve Bieda and his bond was set at \$250,000 cash/surety with bond conditions that he have no contact with the victim and wear a GPS tether.

The Probable Cause Hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, May 2, 2023 at 8:45am and the Preliminary Exam is scheduled for Tuesday, May 9, 2023 at Warren District Court in front of District Court Judge Michael Chupa.

"This is not the example we want to set for children of Macomb County. I support the mission of the Cub Scouts to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and law," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.
