Man Arraigned for Running Drug House with Illegal Guns

Mount Clemens, MI - Today, 41 year old Dionte Carson of Centerline was arraigned in connection with selling drugs.

It is alleged that Carson sold drugs on more than one occasion to an undercover police officer. Officers then searched two residences connected to Carson where they found a large amount of drugs and firearms.

Carson is charged with Possession with Intent to Distribute more than 450g, less than 999g of Fentanyl (30 Year Felony,) Possession with Intent to Distribute more than 50g, less than 450g of Cocaine (20 Year Felony,) Delivery of Cocaine (20 Year Felony,) and three counts of Felony Firearm (2 Year Mandatory Felony,) and Maintaining a Drug House (2 Year Misdemeanor.)

Carson was arraigned in Warren District Court by visiting Judge William Crouchman who set a one million dollar bond. The probable cause hearing is scheduled for Thursday, May 25, 2023 at 9:30 am and the preliminary exam is scheduled for Thursday, June 1, 2023 at 9:30 am in front of District Court Chief Judge John Chmura.

"The defendant's actions represent a clear and present danger to our community. Not only was this man peddling large quantities of dangerous drugs, but he was also running a drug house, creating a breeding ground for criminal activity. Thank you to the Warren Police Department for their hard work in taking this man off the streets," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.

The Macomb County Prosecutor's office represents the people. We are committed to achieving justice and following the laws of the State of Michigan. All that are accused of a crime are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
