Man Guilty of Three Counts of Criminal Sexual Conduct of Minor

Mount Clemens, MI - Late Monday, May 15, 2023, a Macomb County jury convicted Mark Boodry, a 59 year old man from Roseville, of three counts in a criminal sexual conduct case after a four-day jury trial conducted by Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Alexandra Fedorak.

The Macomb County jury convicted Boodry of two counts of Criminal Sexual Conduct in the First Degree (Victim under Thirteen, Defendant over Seventeen) (felony punishable by up to life imprisonment) and one count of Criminal Sexual Conduct in the Second Degree (Victim under Thirteen, Defendant over Seventeen) (15-year felony).

Boodry will be sentenced on Wednesday, July 19, 2023 at 8:30 am in front of Macomb County Circuit Court Judge Joseph Toia.

“I want to express my deep appreciation to the jury for their thorough examination of the evidence and their commitment to upholding justice. The defendant has been convicted on three charges of criminal sexual conduct, revealing the gravity of his reprehensible actions. This verdict serves as a powerful statement that our community will not tolerate the victimization of the vulnerable and we stand united in protecting minors,” said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.
