Man Arraigned for Robbing Two 7/11 Stores

Mount Clemens, MI - Yesterday afternoon, 30 year old Antonio Hall of Detroit was arraigned on two cases in connection with robberies in Warren.

It is alleged that on Tuesday, May 16, 2023 Antonio Hall entered a 7/11 store and ordered two victims to open the cash register at gunpoint. Hall stole the money from the register. Antonio Hall is charged with Armed Robbery (life felony) and Felony Firearm (a mandatory two-year prison sentence).

On Monday, May 21, 2023, Antonio Hall allegedly entered another 7/11 store and walked behind the counter and told the clerk to open the register while nudging the victim toward the register. He left the store on foot without taking anything. He is charged with Unarmed Attempted Robbery (five year felony).

Hall was arraigned in both cases in the Warren District Court by District Court Judge Steve Bieda. Judge Bieda set bond in both cases at \$500,000.00 cash/surety and the defendant must surrender all his firearms, and have no contact with 7/11 stores or the victims. Upon release, the defendant must wear a steel cuff GPS tether. The probable cause hearing is scheduled for Thursday, June 8, 2023 at 9:30 am in Warren District Court.

"Thank you to the Warren Police Department for connecting these robberies. As we unravel the intricate web woven by the defendant, we send a resounding message to all who dare to challenge the integrity of our community: there is no sanctuary for those who trample upon the principles of law and order." said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.
