Former County Employee Pleads No Contest to Stealing Drugs at Macomb County Morgue

Mount Clemens, MI - A former Macomb County employee pled no contest on all charges in connection with drugs being stolen from the Macomb County Medical Examiner's Office in February 2023.

Jocelyn Fetting, 33 years old, took drugs from the medical examiner's office with intent to sell them. Fetting was charged with conspiracy with intent to deliver (7 year felony), delivery of suboxone (7 year felony), delivery of adderall (7 year felony) and larceny of a building (4 year felony).

"The defendant's actions not only betrayed her former colleagues, but also compromised the safety and well-being of the community. Let this be a lesson that the pursuit of personal gain, at the expense of integrity ultimately led to a self-inflicted sentence," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.

Fetting is scheduled to be sentenced on August 30, 2023 in front of Macomb County Circuit Court Judge Matthew P. Sabaugh.

The Macomb County Prosecutor's office represents the people. We are committed to achieving justice and following the laws of the State of Michigan. All that are accused of a crime are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
