Man Arraigned in Breaking and Entering Ring

Mount Clemens, MI - Today, a Detroit man was arraigned for allegedly breaking and entering at two different tobacco shops as part of an organized multi-suspect crime ring.

It is alleged that on Saturday, October 14, 2023, Martez Hunter, age 18, shattered the front window of a Cloud Tobacco and Vape store in Warren and fled in a stolen vehicle. On Tuesday, October 17, 2023 Hunter allegedly committed another breaking and entering at the Hookah and Vape LLC on Van Dyke in Warren.

Hunter is charged with two counts of Breaking and Entering a Building with Intent (10 year felony) Receiving and Concealing a Firearm (10 year felony), and Receiving and Concealing a Motor Vehicle (five year felony). More charges are expected from other jurisdictions.

Martez Hunter was arraigned in Warren 37th District Court by District Court Chief Judge John Chmura. Judge Chmura set bond at \$100,000 cash/surety and upon release he must wear a GPS steel cuff tether. The Probable Cause Hearing is scheduled for Friday, November 10, 2023 at 9:30 am.

"Thank you to all of the police agencies that took part in the task force that broke up this crime ring. We are determined to hold those accountable who threaten the safety and security of our neighborhoods," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.
