Accused bound over to Circuit Court for murder and arson in girlfriend's death

Mt. Clemens, MI - Roseville District Court bound over a 28 year old Detroit man in connection with his girlfriend's murder and the fire that destroyed her home to Macomb County Circuit Court.

It is alleged that on Friday, February 4, 2022 D'Angelo Hubbard entered the victims condo and stabbed his girlfriend approximately seventy five times. Hubbard then began taking the victims belongings from the condo throughout the next two days. Shortly after the defendant left the condo on the second day, smoke started billowing out of the residence. He fled in a stolen vehicle and was later arrested for another offense.

"This was a tragic event and our hearts go out to the victims family," said Macomb County Prosecutor Peter J. Lucido.

D'Angelo Hubbard is charged with felony murder (life without parole), murder one (life without parole), arson (life offense), and receiving and concealing a motor vehicle. Today, he has been bound over to Macomb County Circuit Court. The circuit court arraignment and pretrial will be held on December 27, 2022 at 9:30am in front of Judge Caretti.

The Macomb County Prosecutor's office represents the people. We are committed to achieving justice and following the laws of the State of Michigan. All that are accused of a crime are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
